On Flower Island;

48 glaucous-winged gulls on upper part of island and 33 on rock prominence N end island. no copulating gulls.

11:00 A.M. a band-tailed pigeon flew into top of red alder tree in Spring Cove and preened feathers for 1/2 hour.

12:01 3 mule deer at feeder (NW side house). The adult ♀ prints measured 58 front and 63 hind foot, approx. imation and comparison are: length skull 11", length of body 60", hind foot 13 1/2", height at shoulder 28". The young male (3/4" antler knob) front foot imprint 53", hind foot 48", young ♀ 47 and 43".

A ♀ brown-headed cowbird at porch feeder with a much lighter tawny head and underparts than the other ♀'s in the flock.

measurement of a young mule deer killed last year (at head of stairs): hind foot (hoof) 40 mm.
