

Changed a colored sugar for regular white granulated sugar in hummingbird feeds. The new sugar was more readily accepted than the color sugar that come with the feeder. (1 part sugar, 2 parts water).

3:50 P.M. 88 glaucous-winged gulls on top Flower Island, 46 on prominent rocks on n end island.

5:10 P.M. an adult eagle alighted on tree 100' n of top of Bald Bluff on Blakely Island.

5:45 P.M. 5 turkey vultures n approx. 50' above Bee House. They continued to just beyond Boundary Point, then returned to S.

6:10 P.M. At Lichen Point a red-tailed hawk dove 5 times at an adult bald eagle which was approx. 150' in air. The hawk caused the eagle to react ^{on} each dive. The eagle alighted in a Douglas fir at the point and the red-tailed hawk dove 3 more times, again, causing eagle to react.

The eagle that alighted in tree on Bald Bluff (see 5:10 P.M. notation above) was harassed by a red-tailed hawk. The eagle remain in tree from 5:10 P.M. to 9:06 P.M.

9:06 P.M. above bald eagle left to n along ridge and sailed straight forward without wing beat. At the position above S end airstrip on n end of Blakely it dove (45°) down and increased speed. Lights fading and could not follow the direction of the eagle beyond this point.
