July 2, 1986

Daybreak 3:20 A.M. at 5:30 A.M. N Lopez Sound ~~perfectly~~ calm with Blakely Island perfectly reflected. One meander current meandered S past Leo Reef. Later one log past S Bee House to Lickew Point, thence N and then S again.

5:40 A.M. 7 harbor seal Leo Reef, 7 on north Flower Rock and 1 on Little Flower Rock.

5:41 A.M. first rufous hummingbird at Bee House feeder.

5:50 A.M. 5 rufous hummingbirds at Bee House feeder

8:00 A.M. On ^{top for upper} Flower Island, as viewed from Bee House; 9 glaucous-winged gulls on nests, 9 standing near by. at base of Flower Island on rocky shoreline NW were 7 nesting gulls and 5 standing ^{the 7 nests} near nests and were mates of the nesting gulls.

4 pigeon guillemots walking on slopes of Flower Island.

8:00 A.M. 30 harbor seal on N Flower Rock, 29 on Leo Reef of which were white and one yellowish.
