11:00 P.M. 35 harbor seal Leo Reef: 4 on Rock 3, 5 on Rock 4, 6 on Rock 5 and 10 on Rock 7. measurements of length (nose to posterior end hind legs) 15, 13, 17, 17, 11, 10. width 4, 5, 4, 4, 5.

11:05 A.M. Single ♀ young mule deer on Deer Trail meadows.

no seal on any ^{other} haulouts (such as Flower Island)

11:40 a boat WA 8911 B displaced harbor seal on Leo Reef. Passed by on regular route 150' away.

11:55 30 harbor seal now back on Leo Reef. degree of harassment determines time of return of seals.

12:45 P.M. 31 seal on Leo Reef, none elsewhere.

6:30 P.M. Brown rat selected alternate ^{escape} route from porch. Rather than climbing down tree, retraced his course across porch, past me and down 3 steps to ground. Across porch slow and deliberate, down steps one at a time with hesitation on each step. One brown rat climbed a 1" diameter inclined (15°) Douglas fir tree to 9 feet high then returned to ground. Each step was slow and deliberate and footing tested. Last 3 lower feet fell to ground. Procedure awkward.

5:00 A.M. first humming bird (reefous)

5:30 A.M. 3 band-tailed pigeons

9:00 A.M. Viking Star a tourist boat displaced 6 of 12 harbor seal on Leo Reef. Ordinarily this boat displaces all seal.

10:00 A.M. 15 harbor seal on Leo Reef. 2 measured (overall length) 15 and 16 units in ocular micrometer. As soon as I can determine an exact measurement of any part of Leo Reef beacan I can determine lengths in mm of these measurements. 6 glaucous-winged gulls and 3 double crested cormorant also on reef.

10:20 A.M. 17 harbor seal Leo Reef, 7 glaucous-winged gulls and 2 double-crested cormorants. Seal measured (length) 12, 10, 10, 9, 10.
