The caretaker of bank property said that mule deer do not eat Shasta daisies or poppies. Control of salal by trimming or pulling by roots.

Photo 860723-5 from n end of Orcas Sound at Eastsound showing bay, island and dingy being carried to water. At low tide this island is connected to the mainland. 64 glaucous-winged gulls, 2 American crows and 2 belted kingfisher in area. Fresh water entering sound inhibits green vegetation on flats

at E entrance channel n show in 30° of view across channel are 13 Bonaparte gulls.

In front of Bee House I have noticed mew gulls flying S for the last 5 days.
