July 28 and 29, 1986

Returned Lopez Island. Enroute on ferry observed, 3 pigeon guillemots, 1 common murre, 5 marked murrelets.

At Swift Bay, Low Bank, 43 Bonaparte gulls, 2 greater yellowlegs. At Bee House the food in feeder was gone and replaced at 4:30 P.M. 20 minutes later 2 Townsend Chipmunks and 1 eastern gray squirrel were at feeder. 5:35 P.M. young female at feeder. 10:30 P.M. 2 raccoons at porch feeder.

July 31, 1986

12:00 P.M. 12 harbor seal Leo Reef on Rocks 2-6, 11 on N Flower Rock.

12:10 P.M. all harbor seals on Leo Reef left instantaneously with no boats in area.

4:00 P.M. 15 band-tailed pigeons at disk feeder. Disk 17 1/2" in diameter and 23 1/2" in diameter, harrow disks used in tilling soil.

6:40 A.M. young ♀ mule deer at feeder.

8:15 A.M. 9 harbor seal Little Flower Rock, 14 seal on N Flower Rock, 19 seal on Rocks # 2 and # 5, Leo Reef.

8:20 A.M. 2 young mule deer at feeder.

8:40 A.M. adult ♀ mule deer at feeder.

10:00 A.M. no rufous hummingbird at porch feeder. A week ago 6-10 hummingbirds at feeder but none today.

Brown-headed Cowbirds have not been seen to feed here.

Townsend chipmunk same numbers.

1:00 P.M. Specimen no. 860801-1 and 860801-2 Basilarch lorquini a butterfly from front porch.

1:05 P.M. ad. ♀ mule deer at feeder for 11 minutes.

6:00 P.M. ad ♀ mule deer at feeder.

Bonaparte gulls increasing. Most of them 85%, flying slowly 1 foot or so above water. 15 per cent resting on shore on sands.
