Aug. 5, 1986

Organized for trip to Vancouver, Canada for Exposition. On way to ferry terminal on Lopez Island stopped at Lopez Village. at 11:30 A.M. 2 Turkey vultures soared 150' above ground 1/10 mi. N of Lopez Village P.O. English sparrow in village. Fog banks in several directions, some almost black, others brown, gray or white. On trip to Anacortes along ferry route observed approx 200 glaucous-winged gulls generally distributed on Pointer Island. Checked mt Vernon then continued N on highway 5 to mt. Vernon Thousand Trails, for overnite camping.

Aug 6, 1986

Chris Bee Kenagy and Matthew from Lost Lake (Snahornish Co.) arrived and we all left in Barth for Vancouver to N. Camp at Fraser River Park, at E end of skyway overhead train which we used to communicate between camp & exposition. mat at stage of perpetual motion at expo.

Fuel day at exposition.

Expo. part of day then to mt. Vernon Thousand Trails Camp.

Aug 9, 1986

Left TT for Chris' at Lost Lake.

Aug 10, 1986

Left Chris' for Lopez Island arriving at 7:00 P.M.

Aug. 11, 1986

8:20 A.M. Bimbam and Little Sister both mule deer at feeder at Bee House. and fed for 8 minutes.

10:05 A.M. 15 harbor seal on Leo Reef, 2 in water in circular chasing activity, 1 seal on N Flower Rock.

2:10 P.M. Bimbam and Little Sister fed at feeder at Bee House for 6 minutes, then left.
