Red-breasted nuthatch at Bee House.

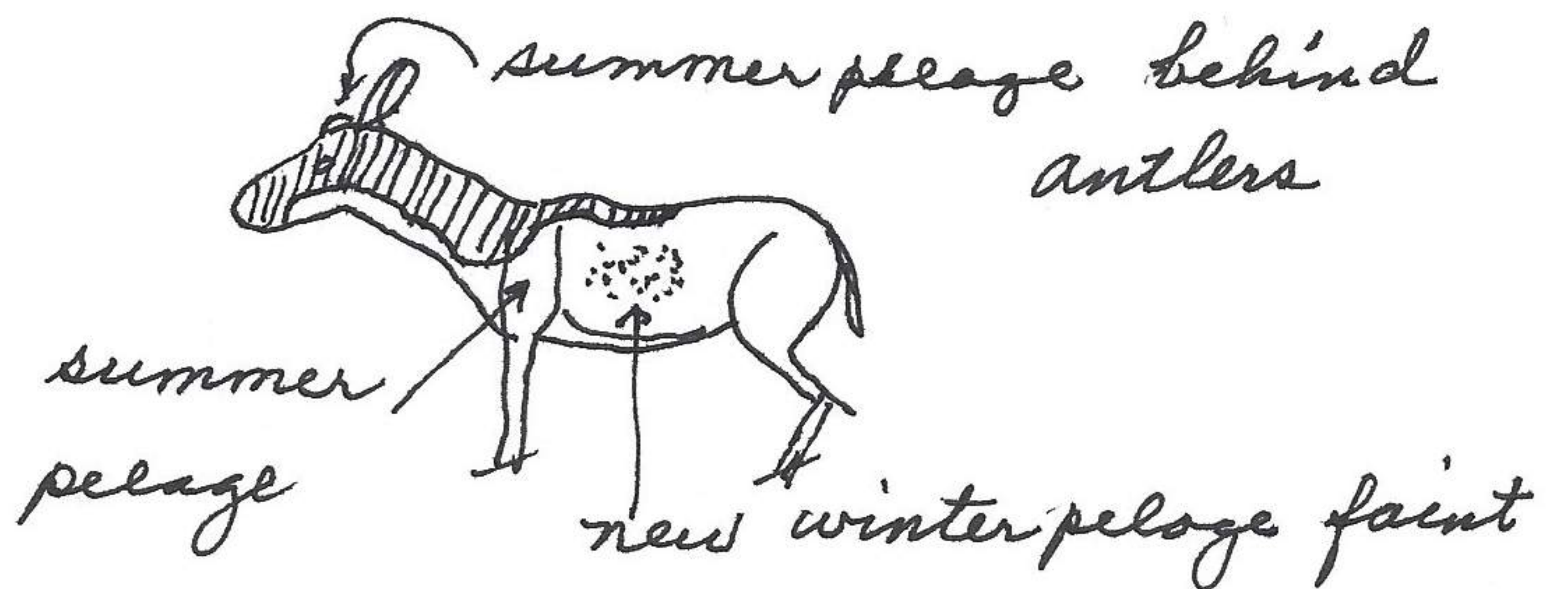
12:00 P.M. House finch occasionally observed at Bee House feeder as singles or 2 or 3 but today 8 fed; all with relatively light plumage.

Sept. 17, 1986

6:30 A.M. all ^{mule} deer except ad ♀ and her fawn. 4 river otter in front Bee House at edge water. In an ad. ♀ pelage darker on neck and stripe above shoulders than on sides. Young ♂ ^{light} hair around antler buds now gone. Lone ♀ adult mule deer in full winter pelage.

3:30 P.M. Osprey circled Hummel Lake. approx. 100' above water. Turkey vulture 1/2 mi. NE Sunset Hardware on Center Road. molt of ♂ mule deer (young)

A young ♂ mule deer noticeably grayer showing winter pelage and more abrupt than any other day to day change.



A young ♂ mule deer groomed fawn. Fawn groomed ad ♀. Lone deer at feeder between dark and daybreak.

3:35 P.M. ♂ house finch at feeder.

A young ♀ mule deer shows no sign of winter pelage except few darker hairs on head.

18 glaucous-winged gulls on Hummel Lake and bathing.

Sept. 18, 1986

All mule deer in local herd at feeder at Bee House, including a ♀ adult strogger. (could be a third ad. ♀ of local group.)

young ♂ mule deer new winter hair head and neck, except ^{hair on} antler stubbs and 2 square inches below ear. Shoulders and sides continuous at upper scapular area and also over ileum of one side to the other. no change in young ♀ except new hair starting on nose.

Fawn same. Ad. ♀ like ♂ young.

Common Raven call on an average every 3rd day, but at times as infrequently as 5 days. Today heard raven call at three different times. These calls come from high on the ridge or in flying over area.
