Oct. 5, 1986

8:20 A.M. 2 adult eastern gray squirrels and 2 young (3/4 size adults). This is the first time we have observed young of the year. Have not observed young of Townsend chipmunk.

The young eastern gray squirrels investigate their environment more than adults who spend all their time feeding. The young move all the time and search out areas never investigated by adults. They are curious about what is on the other side of the house window and are always searching every corner of the window. They are more confident of man's presence. They consume more natural food such as buds of, leaflets of trees including conifers, madrona, ocean spray. Adults forcefully chase the young from the feeder and only after adults have left feeder do the young have access to the feeder. The bobtailed gray squirrel dominates at the feeder.

2:35 P.M. 5 river otter swim S past Bee House and into Spring Cove. A kayak approached cove and all five otter disappeared under water and did not resurface in the general area.

2:50 P.M. 32 double-crested cormorant and 31 harbor seal on Leo Reef. 2 glaucous-winged gulls attempted to land on reef but cormorants rejected them because of lack of space.

861005-1 collected winged termite outside Bee House at 7:00 P.M. These winged termites have been observed flying outside house for at least 2 weeks or since the last recorded specimen taken. They are individual termites and are not part of a flight.

861005-2 Collected a termite from inside log on ground. This decaying log was full of termites.

7:30 A.M. young ♀ and ♂ mule deer at Bee feeder and first deer observed since last recorded except ♂ with one left time observed night before last and last night.
