861010-1 winged termite captured 4:45 P.M. entering pre-established  
 hole in dead Douglas fir. Single winged termites in air  
 from 4:30 P.M. to at least 5:30 P.M. They alighted on Douglas  
 fir bark searching for holes or fissures that led to beneath  
 the bark where they entered and did not leave. One termite  
 on a plastic board that travelled 3" along a straight printed  
 line. while cutting a downed horizontal Douglas fir tree, a  
 termite systematically search a sq. foot area adjoining my  
 hand saw noise and vibration.
