8:15 A.M. family of 4 mule deer at feeder. Each deer, especially adult females thrust heads laterally and upward to make room of limited head room in feeder box. Young female 24" high at shoulders.

Foggy this A.M.

Common loon called several times at 12:30 P.M.

An average of 6 Bonaparte gulls 6(3-10), fed in front Bee House from 9:00 A.M. to at least 1:00 P.M. on sandfish. The glaucous-winged gulls averaged 2 (1-3).

12:05 A.M. 4 river otter swim n past Bee House, at 12' from shore.

Pigeon guillemot averaged 2 (1-3) in front Bee House, Double-crested cormorant averaged 2 (1-3), red-necked grebe 1 and all above from 9:00 A.M. - 1:00 P.M. Visibility in fog from 50'-150' at above times.

4 red-breasted mergansers flew n past Bee House.

1:25 P.M. ♀ Harlequin duck fed by diving.

The dark-eyed junco has been smart regular bird at Bee feeder.

5:00 P.M. Golden-crowned kinglet hit E window and revived in 20 minutes. Total length 93 mm, ♂. 2 brown creepers on trunk Douglas fir at Bee House.

2 American crows at feeder.

On trip to S end Lopez Island did not see crows in fields or elsewhere.

Swift Lagoon: 6 northern pintails, 11 ♂ 22 ♀ buffleheads in Swift Bay

Pond Crows - Stanley Rd junction, 8 mallards and 18 godwits.

Red-tailed hawk Sunset Hardware, Lopez Island.

Winter wren in woodpile Bee House.

Fog to shore in n Lopez Sound at least.

no mule deer to feeder to at least 2:00 P.M.

Birds in front Bee House: Bonaparte gulls, 4-8, feeding in front all morning. 1 mew gull. One group 5 horned grebes, 4 singles.

1 glaucous-winged gull to 20 Bonaparte gulls. Both pelagic and double-crested cormorant. Common loon called, one fed 50' out from shore. a nasal call like geese from fog area. 2 ♀ common mergansers.

Trip to Lopez Village. no birds on Humphrey or Swift lagoons.

Pond at junction Cross + Stanley roads: 89 mallards, 6 ♂ and 8 ♀ northern pintails. no crows in fields enroute.

2:30 P.M. 35 harbor seals on Leo Reef.
