

2:00 PM a fishing group of birds approx. 200' SE Bee House in N Lopez Sound consisted of:

9 Arctic loon, 2 horned grebe, 5 Bonaparte gulls, 2 glaucous-winged gulls, 4 cormorant, 2 pigeon guillemot, 3 ♀ hooded mergansers, 1 ♂ hooded merganser, 3 western grebes, 12 common murre. 2 of the cormorant arrived after the gulls left before cessation of hunting activity of diving birds

2 horned grebes 20' from shore below Bee House.

2 (♀ ♂) hooded mergansers and 1 ♀ common merganser drove fish toward shore on 3 separate occasions.

glaucous-winged gulls associated with diving cormorant capture minnow displaced by cormorant or take minnow from bill of cormorant.

48 American crows at feeder at Bee House.

Winter wren confiding and observed every day, most commonly at wood pile.

The rufous-sided towhee occurs on an average of once every 5 days.

No band-tailed pigeons in last month.

Dark-eyed juncos most common land bird at Bee House.

Golden-crowned kinglet fed thru tops of madroña trees in front of Bee House.

No mule deer today, 2 raccoon last night.

Young ♂ mule deer fed at 2 different times last night. Tracks measured 60 mm.

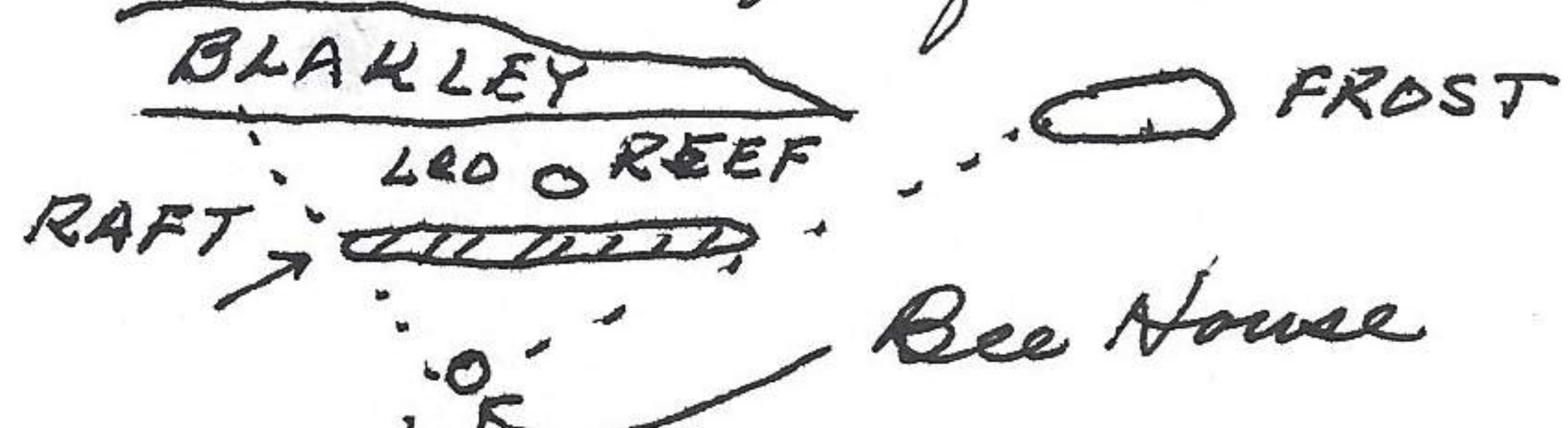
861102-1 *Phomopeus maniculatus hallisteri* 148-67-21-18-16 gms, ♀, wt. normal.

12:00 P.M. 2 ravens called from top of Douglas fir N of Bee Estate. Most calls come from ridge top to SW.

12:10 a raft of 207 Arctic loons in Triangle SE Bee House 1/3
