

associated with Arctic loon were groups of 21, 6, 3 common murrelets, 18 pelagic cormorants, 6 double-crested cormorants, 21 glaucous-winged gulls generally distributed, 6 Bonaparte gulls, 2 marbled murrelets, groups 5, 3 pigeon guillemots. 6 of the Arctic loon had good whitish heads and necks, some chin-straps but mostly mottled bands.

35 harbor seal Leo Reef. also 56 pelagic cormorants, no gulls. The call from Pacific loon sounds geese-like.

12:45 1 California gull on shoreline rocks below Bee House.

Collected the following two insects from near Bee House.

861102-2 Formicid

861102-3 Diptera

5:00 P.M. young ♀ 26" high at shoulders, hind foot 57 mm, front foot 53" (from new measuring panel)

2 roven called at least 6 times this afternoon from ridge to SW Bee House. The call is several guttural "rip", followed by a high pitched click.

Fossil no. 861102-4 in a conglomerate crystal rock from quarry 5 of Humphrey Lagoon.

Track of mule deer measured 82 mm long, young ♀ mule deer at feeder 6:20 P.M.

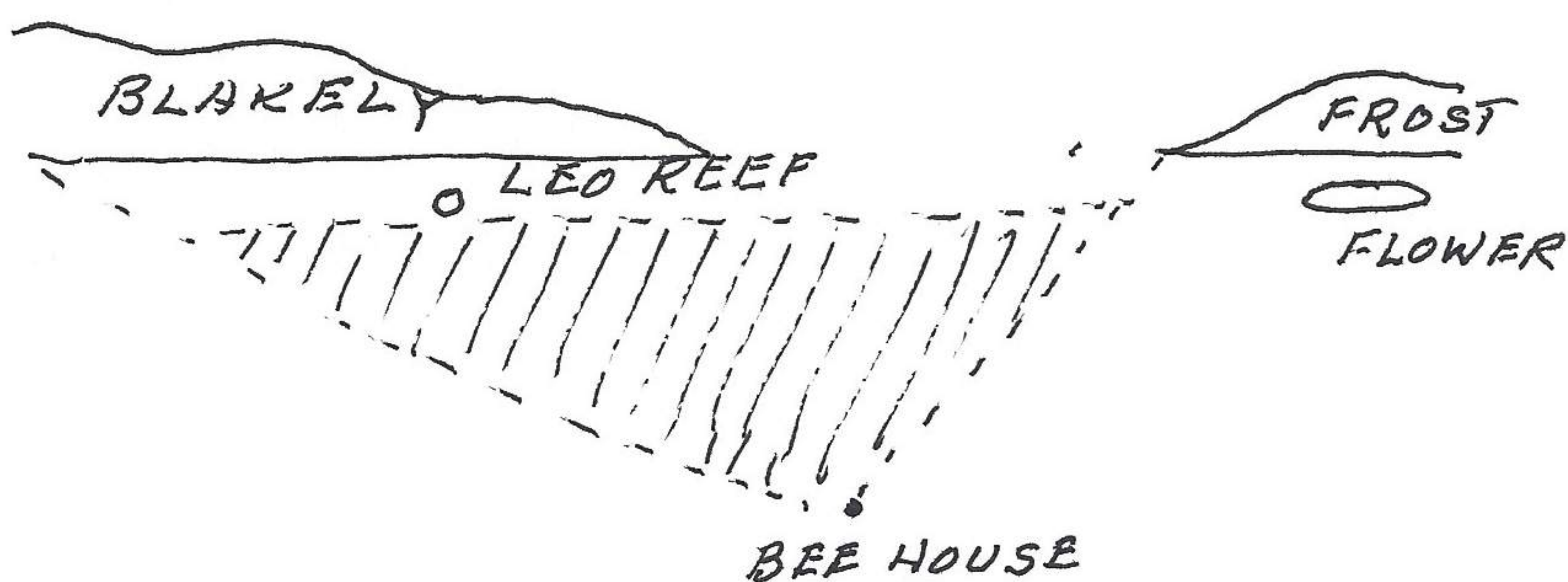

10:30 A.M. Bird in triangle ^{from} 1/5 distance in to n Leo Reef to West Cove, Blakey Island to Frost Island to Bee House.
