861106-1 Peromyscus maniculatus hollisteri 156-67-21.5-17-17gms ♂ testes 5mm.

861106-2 Peromyscus maniculatus hollisteri 163-74-22-18-19gms ♂ testis 3mm
young ♀ mule deer 26" high at shoulders.
fawn ♀ " " 24 1/2" high at shoulders.

4:45 all members of current family group of mule deer at feeder. Stray ♀ came later. While at feeder the stray struck the young ♂ & young ♀ but the young ♂ challenged the stray ♀ with feet thrusting and head up. The stray left feeder.

House finch at feeder for first time since last recorded in journal.

Nov. 7, 1986

High wind and whitecaps. One mule deer at feeder last night.

10:30 A.M. ♂ house finch at feeder.

Have not observed band-tailed pigeon since last recorded in journal about 2 months ago.

Glaucous-winged gull feeding on debris S end Glacial Knoll, Bee Estate.

Mary Pauline Bee, our daughter called from her cabin at Kantishna Lodge, Denali Nat'l Park, Alaska. She reports: Gray wolf tracks in area (Canis lupus tundrarum). Barren-ground caribou, (Rangifer arcticus stonei) increasing. Wang arrived and they are setting up a computer program for Don Asterbrook now at Kantishna Lodge. Winter arriving late this year. River not frozen over. 1 hour daylight.

6:00 P.M. Local family of deer at feeder. All ate 2 pieces of bread each. 2 raccoon on porch each ate 1 slice of bread.

At feeder a raccoon passed 2' from a mule deer. The young ♀ deer recognized the raccoon by putting head low and toward the raccoon and then gave way but ^{the deer} immediately returned to feeder.

Wind Calm tonight and temp 40°F.

Nov. 9, 1986

7:00 A.M., temp 36°F, wind from NE. Waves in front Bee House 19 per minute. Sky above clear, some clouds in southern horizon. Glaucous-winged gulls flying N 1 every 2 minutes on the average.
