

to at least 15' landward of cresting waves on shore edge. The new gull alighted on water and plant mass for a fraction of second and then left up again to 3'-4' to continue their food search. At Swift Lagoon: 2 mallards, 8 ^{northern} pintail. On pond SE junction Cross & Stanley roads: 9 mallards, 6 northern pintails, 3 American widgeon. Hummel Lake: 3 trumpeter swans feeding SE part of lake. Also but not associated with swans are: 4 mallards, 8 American widgeon, 12 greater scaup and approx. 20 other unidentified ducks. On E side of causeway in Fisherman Bay Lagoon: 43 bufflehead, 1 great blue heron. On W side Causeway: 12 bufflehead, 7 surf scoters. On N side Hummel Lake a dead road kill raccoon.

On Leo Reef with rocks 1-6 exposed and only 8 cormorant on reef. There were 12 harbor seal. 1 harbor seal on north Flower Rock, Sky overcast, water calm.

Stray ♀ mule deer 28 1/2" high at shoulders.

at Odlin Park 143 birds in Upright Channel E 1/2 of Channel: cormorant, surf scoter, common tern, marbled murrelet, pigeon guillemot, glaucous-winged gulls (6), 2 bufflehead ducks.
