

Nov. 13, 1986

Adult bald eagle flew S in front Bee House at 7:22 A.M.

Imm. bald eagle flew S in front Bee House at 7:35 A.M. Bath at approx. 50' above water and 40' from shore.

8:20 A.M. Adult ♀ mule deer and fawn (25 1/2 inches high at shoulders)

9:05 A.M. On Leo Reef, 38 double-crested cormorant, 12 harbor seal and 2 glaucous-winged gulls.

9:55 A.M. Young ♂ ^{mule deer} at Bee House 28" high at shoulders. Rain this A.M. and deer wet. Three chestnut-backed chickadees, 2 brown creepers and 2 orange-crowned warblers.

1:20 P.M. 3 pigeon guillemot and 2 marbled murrelets feeding as one group. 1 red-necked grebe 200' away.

1:30 P.M. A harbor seal fished for candlefish 40' out from shore below Bee House. On the consecutive dives it was successful in capturing candlefish.

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11:00 A.M. 51 double crested cormorants and 18 harbor seal on Leo Reef. No bird between Leo Reef & Bee House except 2 glaucous-winged gulls flying by.

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Wind from E to S this A.M. Red-tailed hawk circling S of Bee House.

2:10 A.M. Ad. bald eagle flying N at 250' high past Bee House. Waves 32 per minute.

At dusk stray deer arrived at feeder and then left across Deer Trail Slope to N. 5 min. later adult female and fawn arrived at feeder, then young adult, then young ♂.

Rest of day rain and wind from S.

Nov. 15, 1986

Rain last night and this A.M.

9:00 A.M. young ♀ ^{mule} at feeder by 10:00 A.M. & no other deer in area.

11:30 A.M. mule deer ♂ () at feeder with young ♀ and they are compatible

11:35 A.M. adult female and fawn & young ♂ mule deer at feeder. Young ♂ measured 28" high at shoulders.

12:10 P.M. 10 double-crested cormorant in fishing formation (abreast)
