First song sparrow at deer feeder this season. young mule deer, rain all day. This deer is 28 1/4' high.

Nov. 21, 1986

40 waves per minute at 9:50 A.M. Sun and blue sky.

Nov. 22, 1986

9:00 A.M. Crow called top tree NE Bee House. It sounded like a low-pitched call of a dog calling into a can.

11:45 A.M. fawn at feeder, measured 25" high at shoulder.

2:40 P.M. An adult bald eagle flew over Leo Reef to Lichen Point and then N along crest of ridge.

4:00 P.M. 51 cormorants, 10 harbor seal on Leo Reef. no gulls on Flower Island nor have I seen them there today.

4:10 P.M. 200' SE Bee House 8 double-crested cormorants, 2 arctic loon and 2 common murre in feeding group.

Nov. 23, 1986

Rain and wind from SE all night

7:00 A.M. ^{mule deer} young ♂ at feeder

8:00 A.M. Adult ♀, fawn and young ♀ mule deer at feeder, rain dripping from bodies.

From Bee House collected:

861123-1 Peromyscus maniculatus hollisteri 179-86-23-19-25 gms. ♀
ut normal, not vascularized or enlarged, no plac. scars.

9:10 A.M. Adult bald eagle flew S past Bee House at 40' from shore and 25' above water.

Gulls that are sailing and hunting in high winds are glaucous-winged gulls. They concentrate near shore SW of Bee House when winds drive waves to NW or N.

All mule deer (family) have fed twice at feeder this A.M.

2:00 P.M. Dark-eyed juncos fed all day in rain at feeder.

2:44 P.M. Adult bald eagle flew S along shore of Bee House.
