11:35 A.M. ^{mule deer} fawn, at Bee feeder. The deer measured 25 1/2" high at
 shoulders.

 A 2 foot wave passed thru group and the arctic loon dove while
 the gulls and cormorants rode the waves.

3:25 P.M. Imm bald eagle flew 100' high over water past Bee House
 and went beyond Lichen Point. 2 marbled murrelets swam
 1/2 hour without diving.

4:30 P.M. A young ♂ mule deer 28" at shoulders at Bee feeder.
