

Bonaparte gull, mew gulls. Pacific loons not as common as previously recorded. Common murre generally 1-3 but observed every day. marbled murrelets always present but only 1-4 individuals. Cormorants sp? (but including pelagic & double-crested), and occupying all available surface of exposed Leo Reef, fewer harbor seals, young mule deer more common than adult female and rarely miss a day at the Bee feeder, Bald eagles observed on the overage of 2 (4-1) per day, immatures 3 (5-1) per day, Rhinoceros auklet twice a month. Dark-eyed juncos 6-12 every day and most always same at feeder. Rufous-sided towhee once a day. Finches irregular and 1-3 everyday. Eastern gray squirrel every day and always at feeder. Raccoons every 4 days. Winter wren once or twice everyday in autumn & winter.

This evening all deer (4) at feeder.

Horned grebe swam near shore front Bee House.

2 immature bald eagle sightings this A.M.

The "Shy" deer (mule), ad. ♀, young ♀, young ♂ and fawn at Bee feeder this evening.

testis 7 mm. A cyst, purulent, green and 6 mm long O on left side rectum beneath skin.

Between 7:30 A.M. and 2:00 P.M. 21 sightings of bald eagles consisting of 7 adults and 2 immature. One bald eagle, adult, alighted on beacon of Leo Reef at 10:01 A.M. and left at 12:02 P.M. no other birds came to reef except 12 black turnstones. This A.M. an adult bald eagle and 1 immature eagle dove at a glaucous-winged gull to pirate food held by the gull.
