

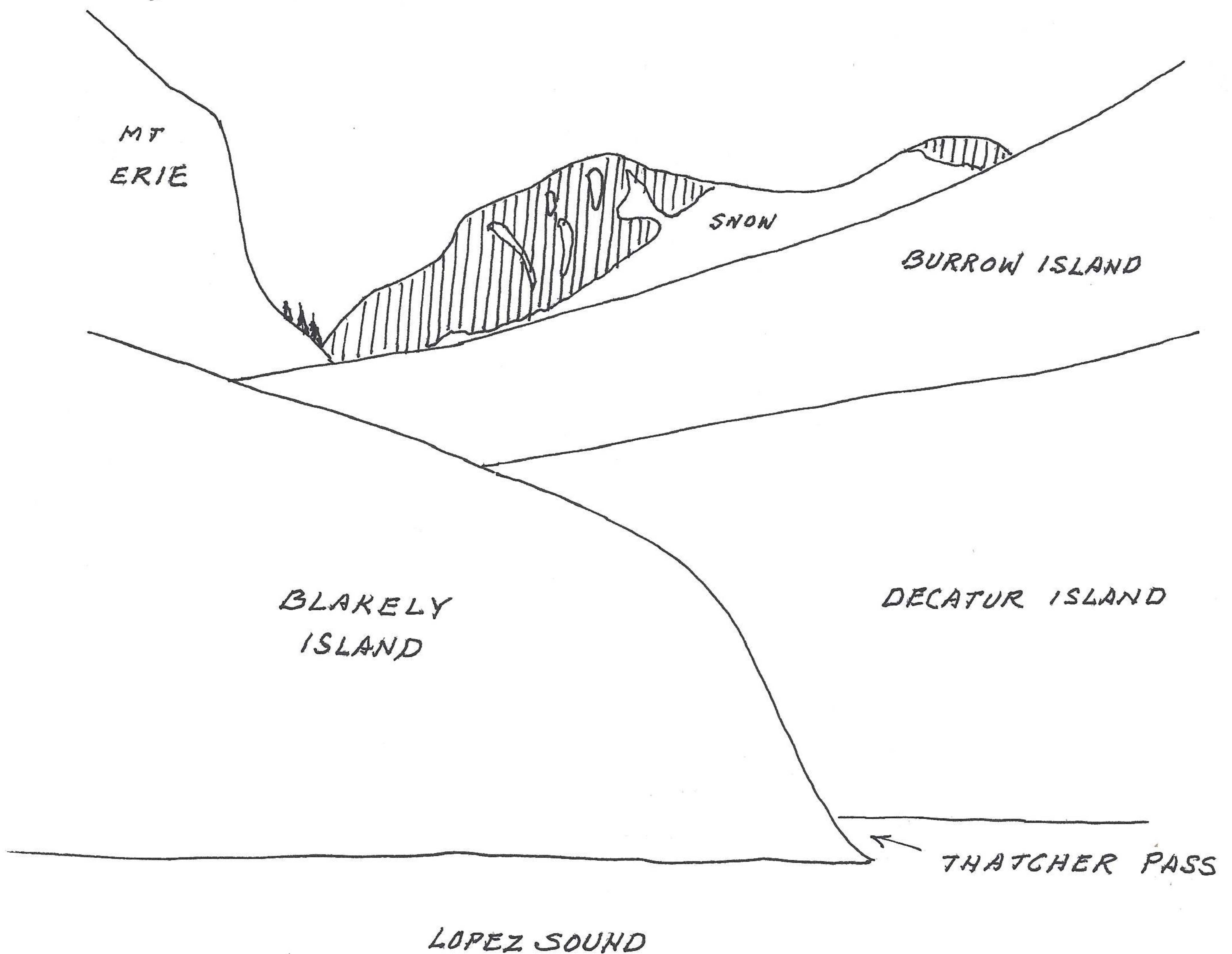
This took place in front Bee House.

3:00 P.M. 3 golden-crowned kinglets in trees near Bee House.

marine birds most active between 8:30 A.M. and 1:00 P.M. Birds observed at one moment: 18 double-crested cormorants, 1 western grebe, 2 red-necked grebes, 14 arctic loon, 9 common murres, 3 common mergansers, 8 mew gulls, 12 glaucous-winged gulls, 2 horned grebes

5:10 P.M. All mule deer at Bee feeder except young ♂. Adult ♂ with right eye tine, 34" high at shoulder; fawn 25"; adult ♀ 30 1/4"; adult ♀_A; Sky ♀.

Recorded a Cascade peak as observed from Bee House. This peak is only observed when atmospheric conditions are favorable in Skagit Valley and along W side Cascades.
