At Humphrey Lagoon: 6 ♂ 6 ♀ buffleheads, 8 American crows, 1 glaucous-winged gull.

This A.m. all local herd of mule deer at ^{Bee} feeder. At noon only young ♂ and young ♀. In afternoon all deer at feeder.

In A.m. to Fisherman's Bay. at causeway w side SW Fisherman's Bay Lagoon observed the following in lagoon from causeway: 10 glaucous-winged gulls, 38 red-breasted mergansers, 18 buffleheads, 2 common goldeneyes, 1 belted kingfisher, 20 surf scoters. On w side of causeway in San Juan Channel, 9 horned grebes, 4 glaucous-winged gulls, 4 buffleheads. At Swift Lagoon: belted kingfisher, 1 northern shrike, 33 mallards, 13 baldpates, 4 pintails. At Humphrey Lagoon: only 2 buffleheads.

11:08 5 river otter swam n past Bee House, one got out on rocks for 15 seconds.

At approx. middle n Lopez Sound in direction of fault n of Bald Bluff 274 Pacific loons, 13 double-crested cormorants and 32 glaucous-winged gulls.
