

Last 3 days windy and gulls, mainly glaucous-winged and particularly from day-break on into A.M., sailed against the wind.

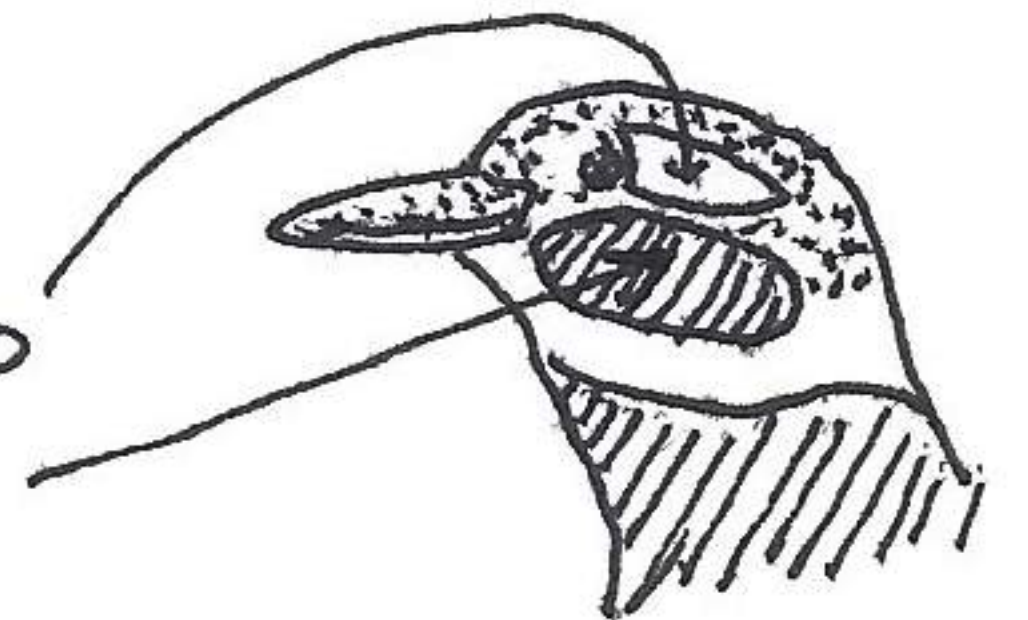
At causeway SW Fishermans Bay, on W side of SW Fishermans Bay Lagoon observed 4 black-bellied plover in *Salicornia rubra* and other salt grass. Also 15 bufflehead. On W side Causeway 9 black-bellied plover on ^{beach at} edge water and 12 dowitchers. Toward S end causeway 1 belted kingfisher.

At Swift Lagoon: 57 mallards. Immature bald eagle flew over Lagoon flying E. Wind all day.

Dec 23, 1986

Calm today. Old squaw duck ♀ at 10:05 fed in front Bee House in an area 20' x 50' for 10 minutes. Average dive 44 seconds. Then swam E to approx 200', thence returned to Bee House and fed in same area until 10:30 A.M.
