

N end Swift Low Bank Beach: 4 glaucous-winged gulls, 6 American crows.


S end Swift Low Bank Beach: 4 glaucous-winged gulls, 1 great blue heron, 1 kingfisher.

Spencer Spit Point (Point between Swift Bay + Spencer Spit): 4 river otter, 1 American crow, 5 song sparrows, 1 kingfisher, 1 winter wren, 1 hooded merganser.

N end Spencer Spit: 4 Common mergansers, 8 buffleheads, 1 common loon, 7 glaucous-winged gulls, 2 horned grebes, 4 sets river otter tracks, 1 winter wren, 4 hooded mergansers, 8 glaucous-winged gulls, 4 double-crested cormorant, 6 ducks (sp.?).

Spencer Spit Lagoon: 1 great blue heron, 81 mallards in 5 groups (they left area), 2 glaucous-winged gulls, 13 northern pintail, 1 kingfisher, 4 song sparrows, 65 American widgeon, 2 mew gulls.

N Spencer Spit Beach: 24 glaucous-winged gulls, 28 mew gulls, 5 American crows.

S of Spencer Spit:  3 bufflehead, 1 glaucous-winged gull, 5 bufflehead, 1 great blue heron, 1 winter wren, 7 bufflehead, 1 great blue heron, 3 buffleheads, 1 hooded merganser.

Point of 100' (long) x 5' (diameter tree) prone on beach: (with roots). 1 common goldeneye.

First stairway on one log: (80' long): great blue heron, 3 buffleheads, 5 common raven, one of which was chasing a bald eagle, 2 oystercatchers

Kennedys (second stairway to beach): ♀ bufflehead resting on log moving in water (log 10' long), log on beach 85' long, 2 glaucous-winged gulls.

Deep drainage to W. (right): tree on beach 80" diameter. This tree had roots, dead bird on beach, partly eaten. Took measurements and drawing of foot (see next page), wing spread 4' 4", white underparts, black back and tail and wings.

Photo 870106-1 of the foot of this bird. Will get identification of this specimen.

An adult bald eagle, 2 raven and 4 glaucous winged gulls fed on this bird. Other tracks of these prey species in sand associated with the dead bird. (See next page for drawing of foot of this bird.)
