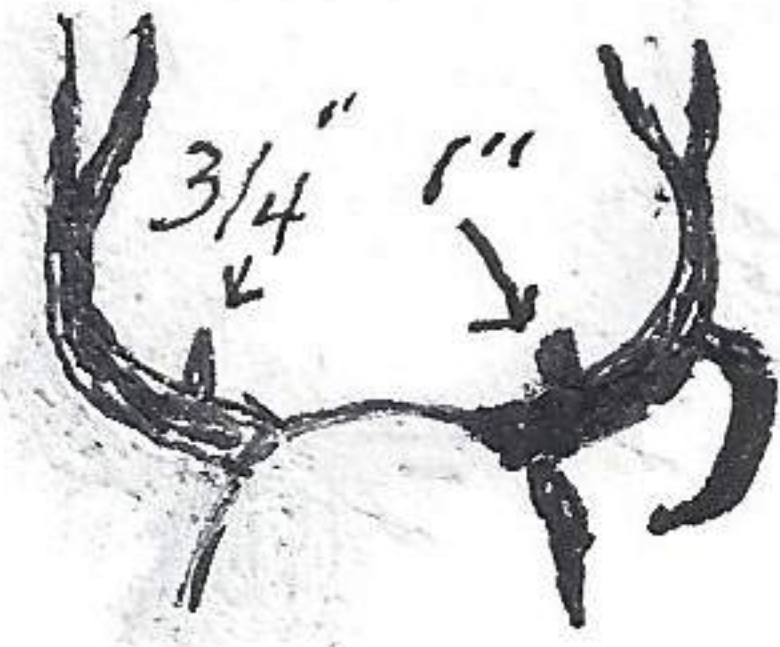


6:30 P.M. adult buck (mule deer) at feeder at Bee House. Antlers with one tine recurved.

Height of mule deer at shoulders 57".



Jan. 13, 1987

6:30 A.M. Daybreak

7:39 A.M. first bald eagle flew S past Bee House, 80' high

7:42 A.M. second bald eagle flew S past Bee House 80' high.

Spent day at Mary & Doris (Babcock residence). Pileated woodpecker edge of forest clearing at base of dead Douglas fir.

Clouds form over Islands.

Jan 14, 1987

Day clear except cloud above Blahely Island. Clouds formed above Blahely and Decatur:



7:22 first bald eagle flew S past Bee House.

7:30 bald eagle alighted in Douglas fir tree directly above Lichen Point, 1/2 way up tree. Also one bald eagle left area of Bald Bluff and flew to Lichen Point and alighted in first tree above point.

7:31 bald eagle flew N past Bee House at 50' level, and out over water 60' from shore.

7:37 6 bald eagles circling 150' above Frost Island, mainly W side.

7:45 A.M. first American Crow ^{of day} at feeder, then 3 more and then 12 more in next 2 min.

7:46 A.M. bald eagle flew S past Bee House at 80' level to Lichen Point, then returned 1 min. later and passed Bee House N at 55' level.

8:06 A.M. bald eagle circled over Leo Reef, thence S to Spence Spit. Another circled above Lichen Point.

8:08 A.M. Sun up on S side Mt Erie

Later this A.M. to Mary & Doris (Babcock Place) and returned to Bee House 1:30 P.M. Bald eagle flew N past ^{Babcock Place} 1/2 way between Bee House and Leo Reef. and moving N. One half hour later another group of 180 moved N in same direction as first group.

Snow last night 1/3 way down Mt. Constitution and on tops
