Joyce Fratic has not seen ^{mule} deer in several week whereas we have them regularly at feeder but generally after dark

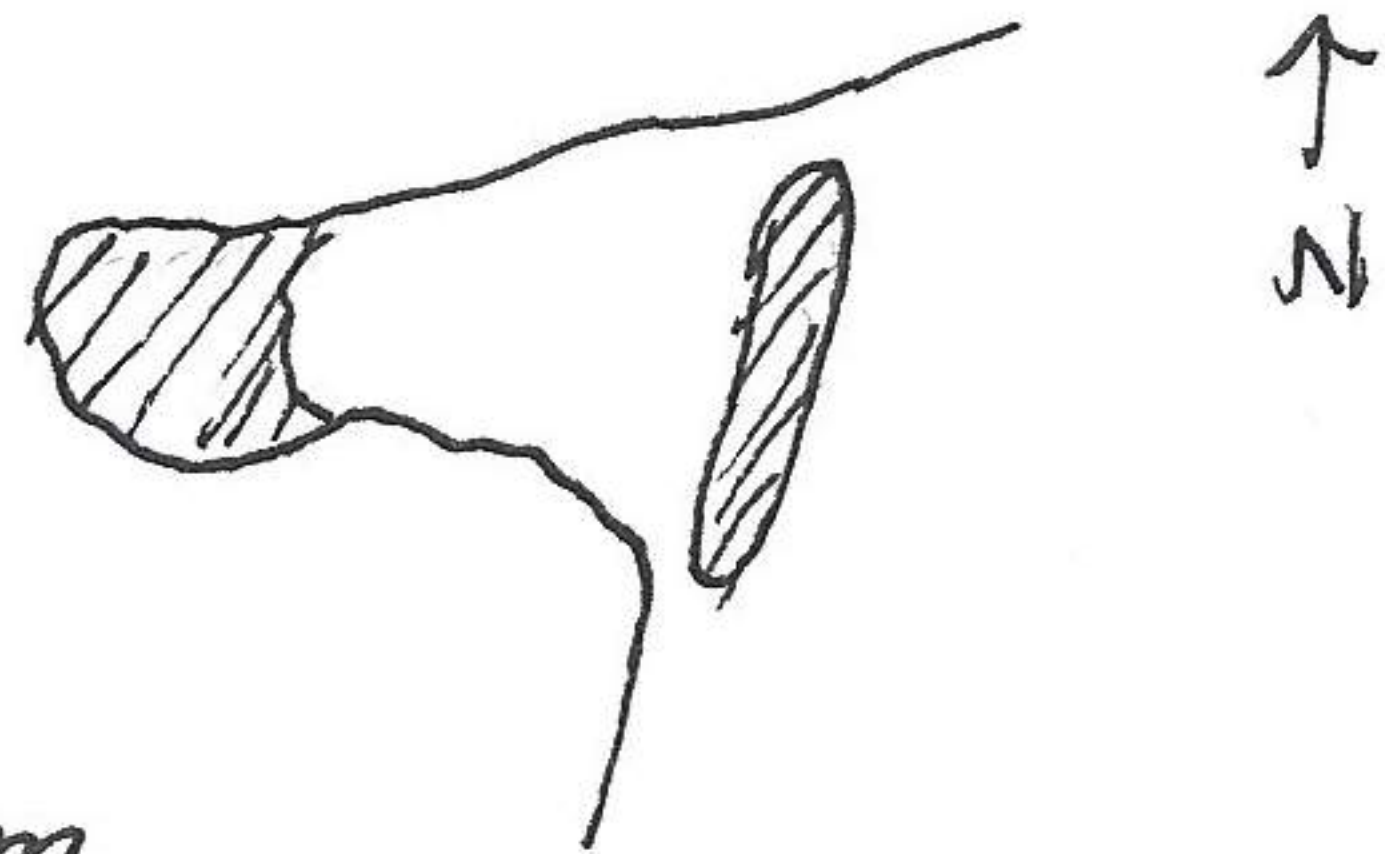
Morning calm.
