

One of the gulls that fed on the floor of the porch attempted to leave by flying into the screen barrier rather than by flying up 3 feet over the railing. I went to the gull after 5 minutes of its confusion, picked it up and released it over the porch railing. One of the tame gulls dominated the other 5. If food is not available on the feeder it will follow top of railing to window where it will peck the window and wait for as long as 20 minutes until food is made available. Food consists of any material that is edible such as bread, all garbage, chicken bones etc.

When 4 or 5 eastern gray squirrels feed on feeder and 20-30 American crows arrive, the squirrels will leave one by one as the greater numbers of crows interact with the squirrels. 3 inches is minimum distance although occasionally a crow will pull the tail of a squirrel. On a one to one basis, the squirrel will dominate.

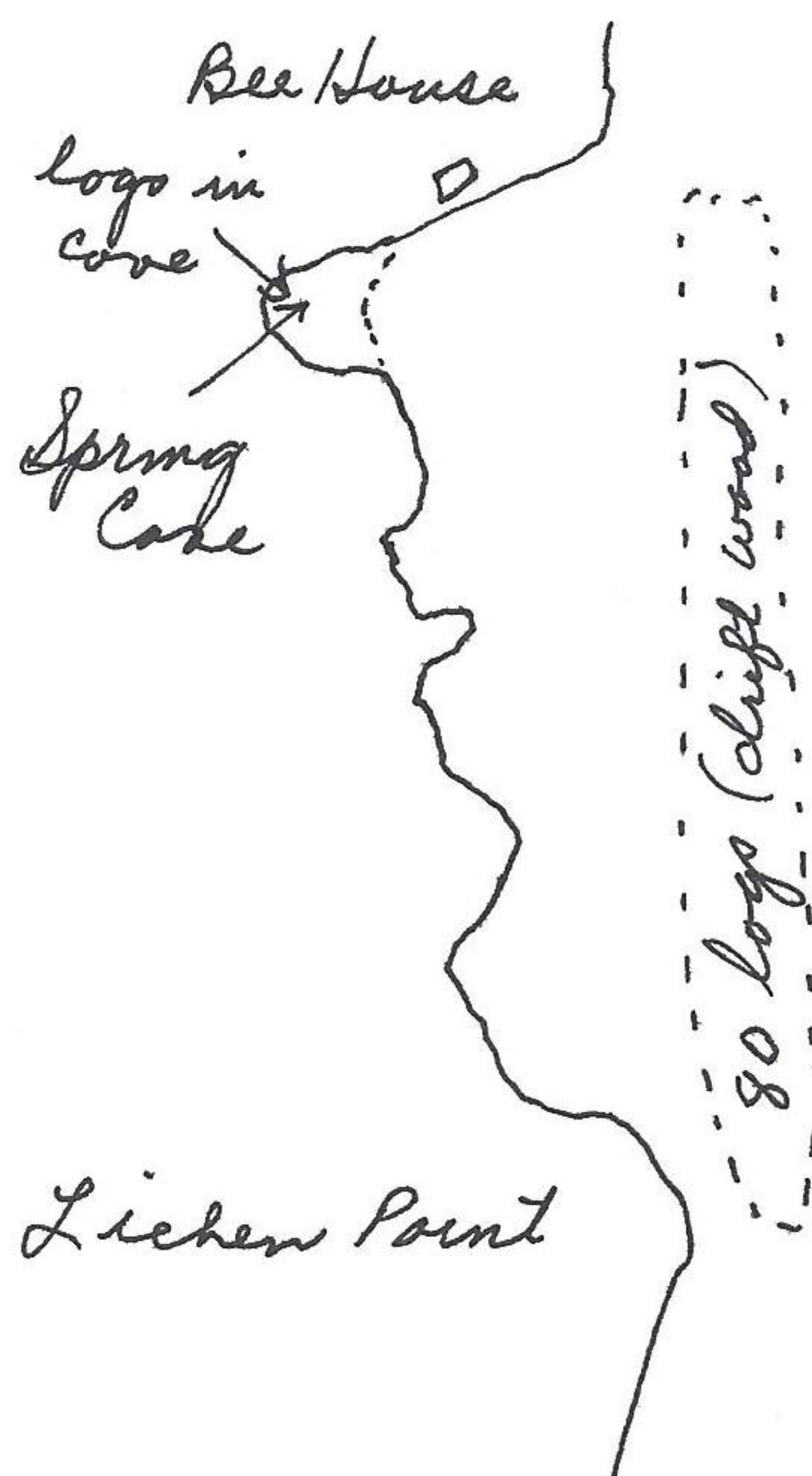

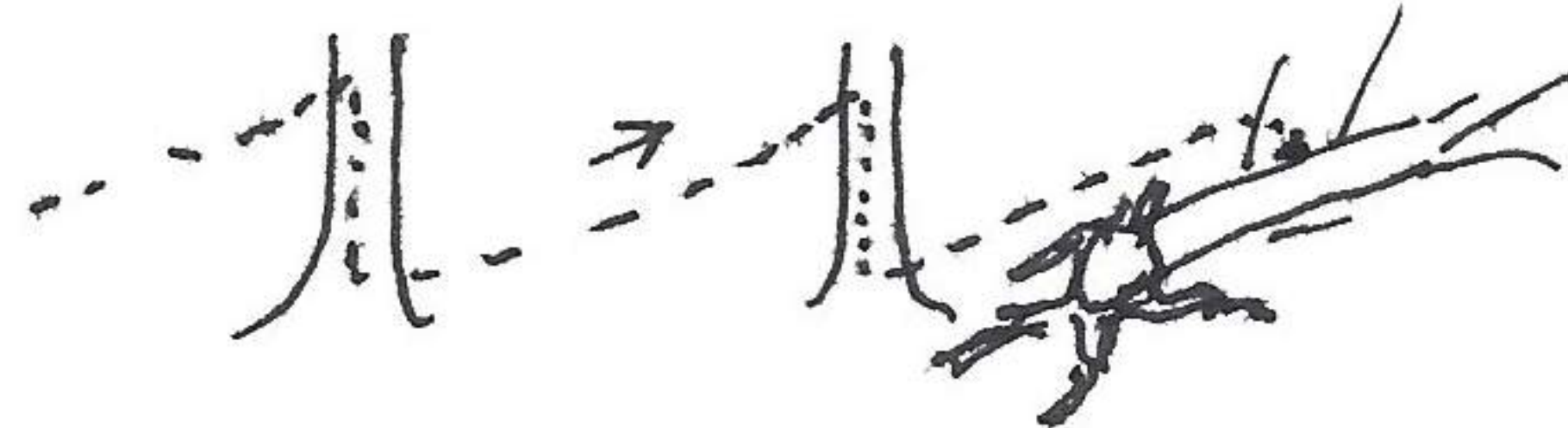
