9:20 A.M. 33 dark-eyed juncos at feeder plus 5 Eastern gray squirrels.

Feb. 4, 1987

7:31 A.M. first bald eagle in area in last 4 days.

8:00 A.M. 43 American crows at feeder.

12:05 P.M. Adult ♀ mule deer at feeder and more wary than Spooky or dominant ♀ of local family group.

Bob & W 4427 KP catches more salmon than 2 a day in front of Bee House.

all local herd of deer at feeder after dusk.

Feb. 6, 1987

10:45 AM 5 river otter swam S at approx 200' from shore at Bee House.

3:00 P.M. 2 adult eagles on Leo Reef standing 1 foot apart.

at N Rock Quarry from top observed 3 river otter swimming and diving as they moved north along shoreline.

A Cooper hawk flew across Shoal Bay to N Rock Quarry and then turned north around high point.
