

Bewick wren, chestnut-backed chickadee, golden-crowned kinglet, ruby-crowned kinglet, rufous-sided towhee, Thayer gull, glaucous-winged gull, mew gull, song sparrow, red-breasted merganser, horned grebe, brown creeper, western grebe, surf scoter 5♀ 7♂, Wilson snipe, sandpiper sp., dark-eyed junco

Left T.T. and drove to State Park on E side Padilla Bay and recorded the following birds: approx 1000 brant in 4 main groups, 33 glaucous-winged gulls, 6 northern pintails, 24 bufflehead, 2 cormorant, 4 common loon, 4 great blue heron, 4 American crows, 42 American robins in one flock, 1 Am. rough-legged hawk, 18 Brewer blackbirds, 41 brown-headed cowbirds and 1 adult bald eagle.

On E side marsh Peninsula (entire) observed: 14 northern pintail, 35 American widgeon, 1 hooded merganser, 1 ^{w.} meadowlark 15 brant, 48 glaucous-winged gulls, 1 common raven, approx 800 brant, 4 harbor seal and 24 glaucous-winged gulls associated, 15 Brewer blackbirds, 43 brown-headed cowbirds, 1 arctic loon. White on rear of brant good field mark at distance.

The white wing patch on red-necked grebe is conspicuous at it leaves water.

On W side marsh Peninsula: 483 double-crested cormorants, approx 5000 greater scaup, 247 glaucous-winged gulls, 71 mew gulls, approx 1500 northern pintails, 82 buffleheads, 407 American widgeon, 3 European widgeon, 117 green-winged teal, 14 American robins, 1 song sparrow.

At Anacortes (State) ferry terminal in bay to SW: 1 glaucous-winged gull, 43 mew gulls, 3 Thayer gulls, 3 double-crested cormorant, 1 red-necked grebe, 15 buffleheads, 6 common golden-eyes, 11 American crows, 3 pelagic cormorants, 2 American widgeon, 4 red-breasted mergansers (2♀, 2♂), 2 great blue herons.

mew gulls have dusky heads, never pure white and dark around eyes.

Left on ferry 4:00 P.M. for Lopez. (Censuses included 1/10 mi each side ferry) adult bald eagle circled above water to E, dropped to water, raised or glided upward to 8' above water, hovered 10 second then left circled again and returned to same spot then left to E. 2 glaucous-winged gulls harassed entire time. 4 mew gulls, 1 common loon, 1 glaucous-winged gull, 1 common loon, 1 red-breasted merganser, 1 glaucous-winged gull, 1 marked murrelet, 2 pelagic cormorant, 4 surf scoters, 1 horned grebe, W Thatcher Pass, glaucous-winged gull, 1 marble murrelet, 1 double-crested cormorant, 3 pelagic cormorant, 1 glaucous-winged gull, 13 pelagic cormorants (on floating log), 2 double-crested cormorants.
