1:00 P.M. 1 river otter ^{20' out from shore} swam 5 past Bee House.

3:00 P.M. Snowed to Bald Bluff on Blakely Island.

Overcast and brisk wind. 8 glaucous-winged gulls hovering in front Bee House using wind.

8 sightings of bald eagles up to 9:00 A.M.

Birds on Swift Bay Low Bank: 18 American Crows, 8 greater scaup, 9 glaucous-winged gulls, 2 bufflehead ducks.

at Swift Lagoon: 18 gadwall, 3 buffleheads, 14 green-winged teal, 1 killdeer, 8 northern pintails

at Hummel Lake: 4 American coot, 3 bufflehead, 6 glaucous-winged
