Townsend Chipmunk active today

American crows along shorelines but not in fields.

March 3, 1987

Wind all day, occasional rain. On Leo Reef 31 harbor seal and 6 black oystercatcher.

March 4, 1987

52 glaucous-winged gulls on Flower Island and generally distributed. Only 10 pairs, rest singles.

43 american crows on Bee House feeder (12 sq. feet) 

Townsend Chipmunk at feeder every day since first observed march 1.

March 5, 1987

From Bee House collected:

2:00 P.M. 12 harbor seal and 13 pelagic cormorants on Leo Reef (at low tide)

March 6, 1987

From Bee House collected:

870306-1 Peromyscus maniculatus holisteri 177-81-22.5-19-22 gms. ♂ testis 9 mm.

3:30 P.M. 31 harbor seal and 17 double-crested cormorants on Leo Reef.

3:45 P.M. 1 river otter swam n past Bee House out 20' from shore.

4:20 P.M. 6 common mergansers swam n past Bee House with head to eye level beneath water for 3' to 4'

6:15 P.M. first myotis, wing span approx 5". Temp. 50°F.

6:15 P.M. family of deer at feeder.

6:31 P.M. myotis still flying past 3rd story windows of Bee House and water side.
