Denny and Judy Bailey of Lawrence, Kansas arrived. On trip of Lopez Island note: pigeon guillemot at Richardson's Store; bald eagle in tree at Hummel Lake; 13 gadwalls, 2 buffleheads, 2 northern pintail; at Surf Bay Low Bank, 1 surf scoter, 23 greater scaup, 18 glaucous-winged teal, 1 great blue heron, 12 American crows; at Humphrey Lagoon, 9 bufflehead, 2 great blue heron, 2 Canada geese (two sizes), 8 American crow, 2 common goldeneye; 1 river otter swimming S past Bee House.

March 15, 1987

To Friday Harbor, enroute: 5 red-necked grebes, 22 pelagic cormorants, 4 double-crested cormorant, 17 glaucous-winged gulls, 2 common murrelets, 12 marbled murrelets, 7 pigeon guillemot, 6 surf scoters, 1 bald eagle N end Upright Head, 1 river otter swimming S 20' out from Bee House and 1 varied thrush and 1 harbor seal, 4:30 P.M.

March 16, 1987

On trail, W side Humphrey Head, 2 ruby-crown kinglets, 1 winter wren, 2 robins.

at Bee House a pileated woodpecker flew S across out Spring Cove, down shore to Round Point.

This A.M. 9 harbor seal on Leo Reef and in afternoon 16 of them, 6 black turnstones on Flat Point.

2:00 P.M. bald eagle circled about 300' above Lichen Point.

3 greater yellowlegs Humphrey Lagoon.

First day deer fed in A.M. at Bee House (11:00 P.M.)

1 raccoon of Bee House for last 3 days and after dark.

4:14 P.M. Immature bald eagle on Rock No 3 on Leo Reef. 4 harbor seal on Rocks Nos 4
