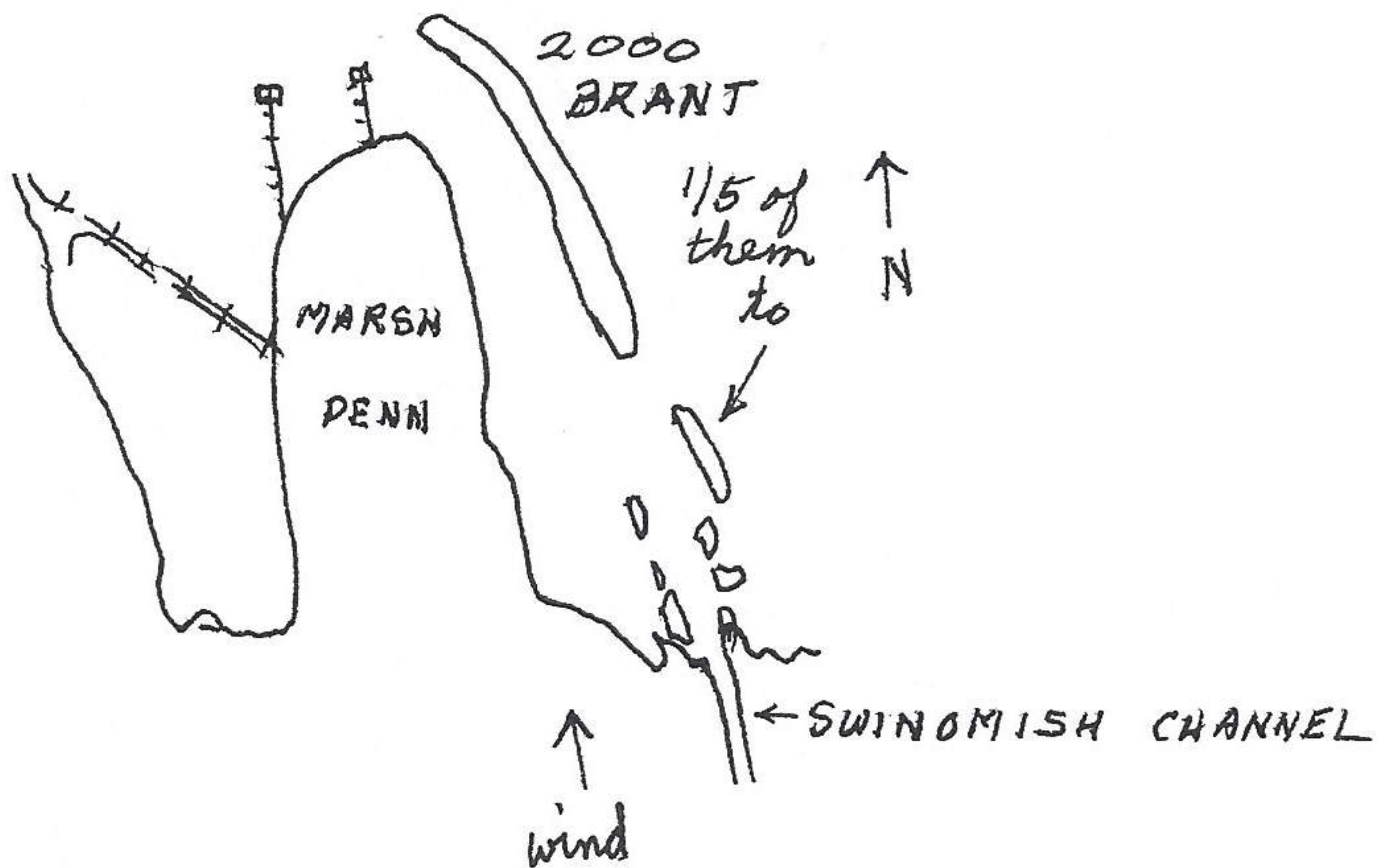

Check marsh peninsula: Between two pipelines over water observed 2 mallards

120 greater scaup

98 common goldeneyes

6 glaucous-winged gulls

6 surf scoters

6 pairs (in addition to above) glaucous-winged, performed nuptial behaviorism, bending over, opening mouths and bobbing head.

One west side of marsh peninsula (low tide) 7 of R.R. causeway were: 1 great blue heron, 45 american widgeon, 32 buffleheads, 31 greater scaups, 2 common loon, 4 mallards, 3 double crested cormorant, 1 robin, On S side R.R. causeway, 120 mew gulls, 18 glaucous-winged gulls, 2 great blue herons, 24 greater scaup, 17 northern pintail, 85 american widgeon, 120 dunlins.
