

April 10, 1987

The number of glaucous-winged gulls sailing in front Bee House is proportional to velocity of wind blowing from S.

9:00 A.M., second appearance of band-tailed pigeon to Bee feeder, this season.

Trip to Lopez Village: at Swift Lagoon: 14 green-winged teal, 7 greater yellowlegs, 3 American widgeon, 25 gadwalls, 1 belted kingfisher, northern violet green swallows every 30' above water surface.

12:00 P.M. 25 glaucous-winged gulls, 2 Canada geese and 2 American crows on Flower Island.

12:10 The above crows left Flower Island and flew directly to feeder at Bee House, in fact it alighted on feeder. 2 great blue herons left shore below Bee House and flew S.

12:15 P.M. 35 glaucous-winged gulls on Flower Island, 3 of them were paired. Second visit of band-tailed pigeon to Bee feeder this season. No harbor seal on Leo Reef.

1:30 P.M. An immature bald eagle circled upward approx. 300' E Bee House and then flew and sailed straight to Blakely Island (above fault line).

Two immature bald eagles circled over NW end of peninsula in Barlow Bay W of junction Alekes Bay Road and Mackaye Road. 42 bufflehead in Barlow Bay.

A immature bald eagle circled 300' high 7/10 mi N of Lopez Village.

at Swift Lagoon: 8 greater yellowlegs, 18 gadwalls, 14 green-winged teal, 2 common mergansers, 1 great blue heron.

6:05 P.M. 1 river otter swam N from Lichen Point, put-out Flat Point, walked to Dissected Point and put-in, and swam N where it met 3 other otter swimming S. The otter going N caught a Pacific staghorn sculpin. Leptocottus armatus. Two of the otter going S turned and followed 2 feet away from the otter and its captive fish, but neither challenged for the fish.

6:10 P.M. Immature bald eagle circled above Lichen Point then flew to dead tree on Joyce Fralich property.

8:40 A.M. river otter swam S in front of Bee House,

4:35 P.M. mule deer at feeder. young ♂ measured 29 1/4" high at shoulders.
