

bald eagles. (again this does not mean different individuals).

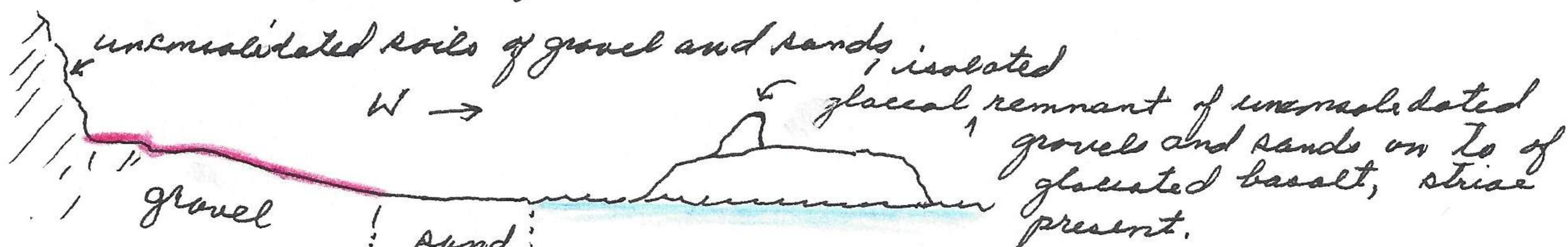
2:10 P.M. 5 harbor seal Les Reef, 15 glaucous-winged gulls Flower Island.

3:00 P.M. To Agate Beach, enroute: Osprey carrying fish taken in Swift Bay flew to top of Douglas fir 4/10 mi. W of entrance of Swift Lagoon into Swift Bay. Bald eagle 2/10 mi W Grange Hall and 1 turkey vulture 3/10 mi E Mackaye Harbor Road. and Mud Road Junction.

at Swift Lagoon 13 green-winged teal, belted kingfisher, 5 northern shovellers, 11 gadwalla, 2 mallards. On Swift Bay Low Bank on beach: glaucous-winged gull chasing crow that had food in bill.

April 22, 1987

860422-1 Collection of beach rocks on Agate Beach State Park. on Lopez Island. (Outer Bay).



Gravel from 4" to size above coarse sand. Flat benches base mainland flattest rocks. There is no segregation of kinds of rocks on beach except shape. Best striae preserved below low tide.

11:40 P.M. Adult bald eagle alighted in madrone in front window of Bee House, 30' away. It remain for 30 minutes.

2:10 P.M. river otter swam 5 feet Bee House. It would dive and swim under water for 18' or so and then surf for air for 4'-5' then dive again.

2:18 P.M. marbled murrelet 20' out from shore below Bee House.

7:50 P.M. young ♂ mule deer 49" high at shoulders.

April 23, 1987

Before 7:00 A.M. 2 bald eagles (an imm. and adult) in tree (Douglas fir) above Lichen Point. Waters smooth.
