It adjusted itself and fell back over edge of sill where it hung by one foot. at that point it stopped breathing and in 2 seconds dropped to ground 1 ft below. no other hummingbird reacted to the death & fall of this bird. as soon as it alighted on ground, venter up it was lifeless.

weight of this bird is 3.3 gms. It was observed that as the sun came out later in the morning, the ruffled out of feathers resumed the normal contour of the hummingbird. Its death was associated with this increase of temperature and may be the ^{final} cause of its death.
