On the overage there are not as many birds tonight (8:10 P.M.) as last evening.

10:10 A.M. family deer came running down trail from midtrail to N (above Otter Cove). They feed & had apple slices and then all went NW up trail to top steps & the to N.

4:00 P.M. 6 rufous hummingbirds at feed and not as many as last 3 days. Day brilliant, no clouds, slight breeze Temp 67°F
