

Today water shimmering on all surfaces exposed to sun reflection. There was a uniformity of surface reflection.

At 7:40 P.M. recorded numbers of rufous hummingbirds at feeders (3) on porch.

7:40^{P.M.} - 3

7:50 - 3

8:00 - 6

8:10 - 5

8:20 - 7

8:25 - 7

8:28 - 7 (2 river otter swim by to S)

8:35 - 5 (set 50-50)

8:40 - 5

8:45 - 5 (tame glaucous-winged gull left to S_N). It ^{to Swift Bay. direction,} gave 2 quick notes just before takeoff.

8:47 - 10 arrive suddenly and all feed compatibly at feeder each taking turn. Prior to this group, individual hummingbirds commandeered each feeder and would spend most of its time working off other hummingbirds.

Of the 10, 9 were ♂, 1 ♀.

8:50 all left except 1 46 surf scoters to N in single line 1-2 feet above water.

8:55 2 males

8:58 2 males

9:00 1 male

This male fed for 2 sec intervals then rested on branch 1 1/2 feet away for 5 second.

9:02 above male left area abruptly after ^{2 sec} feeding at feeder. To travelled S along shoreline.

9:05 P.M. young ♀ came to deer feeder and left as did the ♀ of 7:00 P.M. - 7:20 P.M. It would be compared to a second year young.

May 7, 1987

11:30 A.M. 3 rufous hummingbirds at feeder. There has been a decrease in numbers of birds (hummingbird) at feeder.

11:35 A.M. 10 band-tailed pigeons at deer feed NW of house. Most of them remain in trees above cliff while 2-3 feed at a time at feeder.
