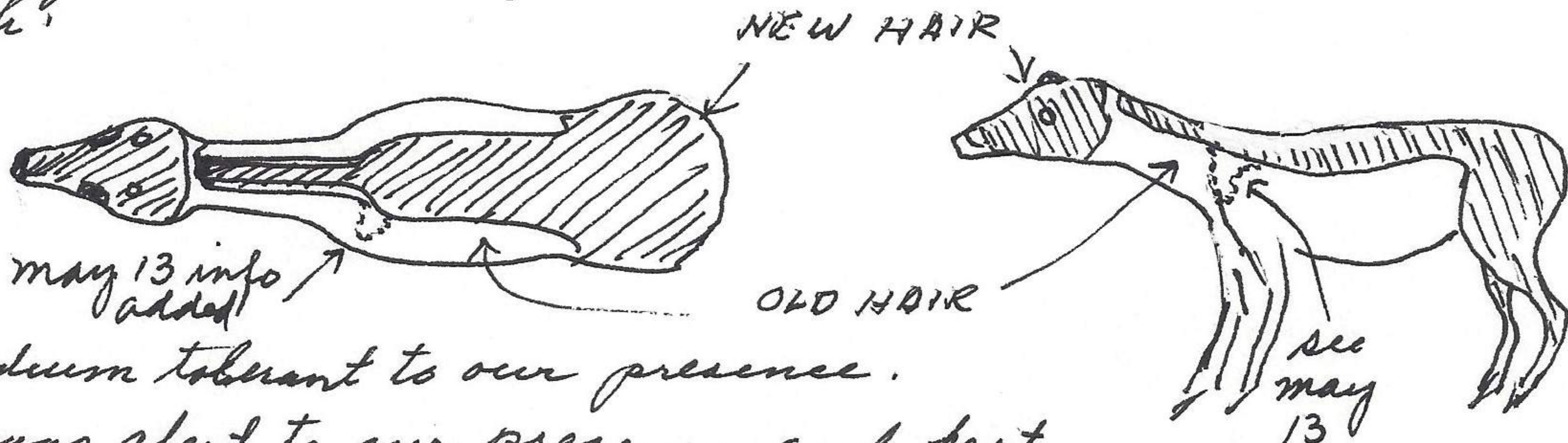

5:20 P.M. Two non territorial mule deer came to feeder. young buck (third year) 30" high at shoulders, antlers 1/2" high.



medium tolerant to our presence. It was alert to our presence and kept eyes on us as it fed. when startled ran up trail to Top of cliffs, stopped and then walk N on middle trail.

Observed a turkey vulture 150' above Conifer on ridge W of junction Spencer Spit Rd and Port Stanley Road.

at Swift Lagoon 6 (3♂, 3♀) blue-winged teal.

at N Beach of Spencer Spit collected rock samples.

This evening wind changed from the N (last 3 days of clear weather) to from S.

8:00 P.M. 1♀, 1♂ rufous hummer at porch feeder.

May 10, 1987

7:00 A.M. First time in a year (at least) that a dynamic tide current has occurred at Boundary Point and in front of Bee House. There were upwells, whirlpools and fast moving water. Continued to 7:25 A.M. at which time it was normal surface. One log 1 1/2' x 8' swung in arc in 3 seconds. The circulation was lee of point.

7:35 A.M. Immature bald eagle (white feathers in head and white across front) alighted on rocky shore to investigate carcass of muskrat placed there

for such purpose. It left as I moved from the window.

9:50 A.M. to Rosario Resort for Mother's Day Brunch and then to Cascade Lake where we hiked 2.5 miles along its perimeter, no aquatic birds on lake. at bay on W side met Mr. Bob Hamblin who directs and own Arcon Spectrum Video. He
