

at Pointer Island glaucous-winged gulls every 2-5' apart and more crowded than on Flower Island. Color of water in Rosario Straits green. Log every 125' in straits. Cassin's murrelet. no other birds on trip. Continued on from Anacortes to Chris'.

May 17-18, 1987

at Chris' at Lost Lake. Left for La Conner Thousand Trails Preserve.

May 19, 1987

2 hooded mergansers in lagoon at Thousand Trails Preserve. On beach at Lone Tree Point. 2 black oyster catchers, 2 glaucous-winged gulls, 1 kingbird and 3 crows. Birds in lagoon scarce compared to winter season. Left and at Anacortes Ferry Terminal noted 4 mallards, 1 double-crested cormorant, 2 glaucous-winged gulls, 1 great blue heron. In the building SW of ferry terminal is a note written on the wall "Swallows arrived 6:30 P.M. April 11, 1975." Red-shafted flicker called nearby.

Boarded ferry at 11:04 A.M. and will keep complete censuses (both sides ferry) to Lopez Island: 2 pigeon guillemots, 2 pigeon guillemots, 1 pigeon guillemot, one Cassin's murrelet, Pointer Island gulls 2-5' apart, 2 Cassin's murrelets, passing Jackson Rocks.

11:25 W end Thatcher Pass no NW; 2 glaucous-winged gulls, 2 Cassin's murrelets, Lopez Terminal 11:42 A.M. 4 immatures, 2 ad glaucous-winged gulls on peling at ferry terminal.

Continued to Humphrey Head on Lopez Island.

5:00 P.M. young ♀ of family group feed at feeder. This
