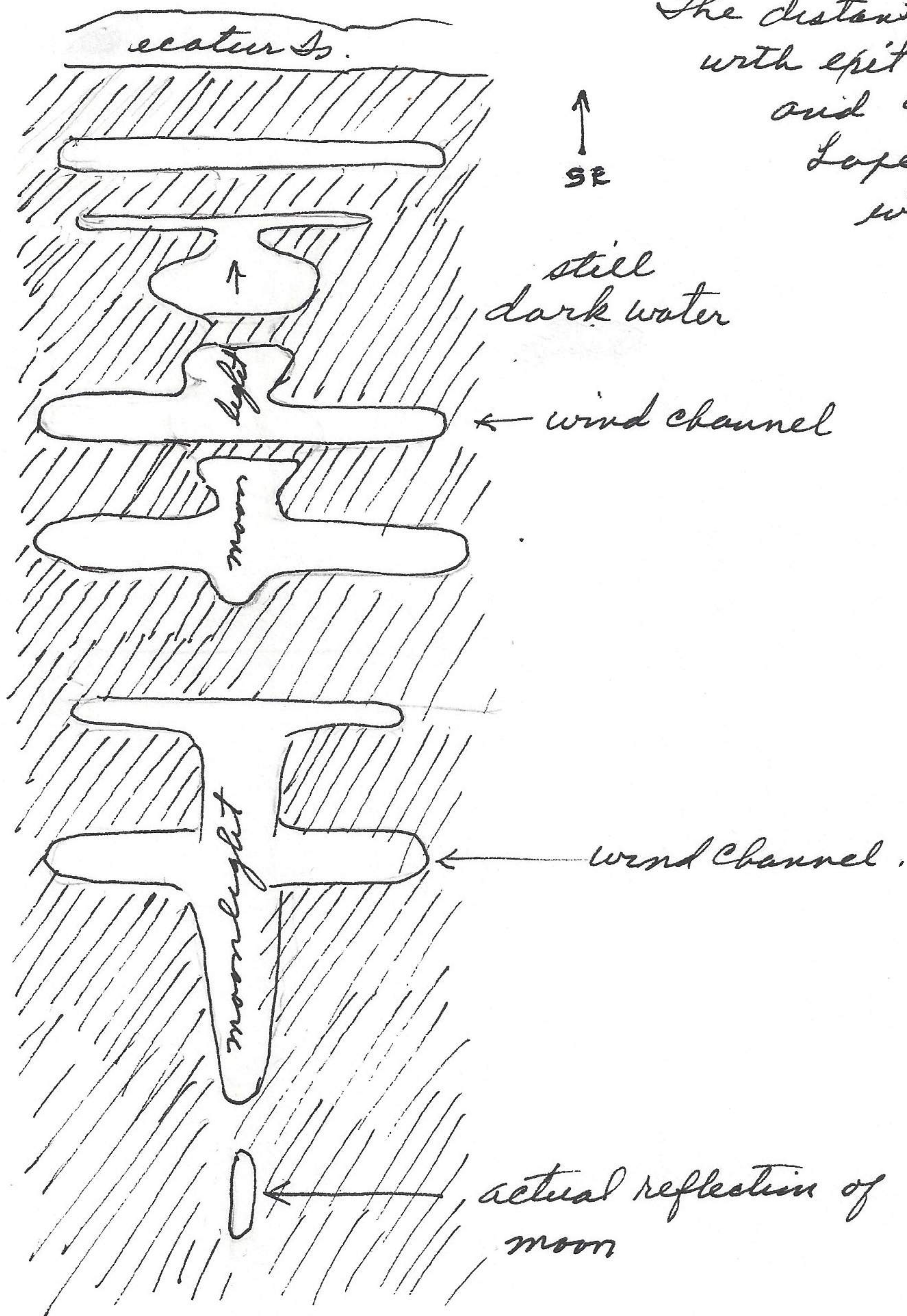


Bee Estate, Humphrey Head, Lopez Island, San Juan Co., Washington.
 May 20, 1987

Early this morning before daybreak moon reflected on water. The central reflective angle was approx $10' \times 2'$. at times this reflective area to almost perfect moon image $4' \times 2'$ with only slight movement of water. at times in the past I have witnessed perfect moon and star reflection. At times the moon reflection extended from shore at house to Decatur Island, sometimes in the distance broadening to $2/10$ mi. Sometimes slight winds at various places would produce a localized broad beam with intermediate still black water

The distant sound associated with exit of Thatcher Pass and winds from South Lopez Island occasionally were widely covered with shimmering moonlight.
