

competed for the inspection. This group left and finally one pair persistently inspected the nesting box by landing at the hole in the box but never going completely into the box.

may 23, 1987

northern violet-green swallow (pair) entered box for first time only on sighting of bald eagle today (adult)

may 24, 1987

northern violet green swallows carried dry grass stems, some to 14" long into nesting box. Short stiff twigs inhibited swallows from entering because of crosswise arrangement of building material held in mouth. They finally get it in the box by taking hold of one or the other ends but this may be a random readjustment of the material in their mouths. 2 sightings of bald eagle today.

Pair of northern violet-green swallows carried nesting material into nesting box. I would not be positive the only one or both contributed to nest building.
