10:00 A.M. to Orcas Island with Annette, Jim & Liz. Brunch at Rosario Resort. Drove top mt. Constitution and on return to Cascade Lake counted 9 robins generally distributed along the way. From sound N Eastbound observed 8 pigeon guillemot in one group and 2 marbled murrelets. To W Beach counted 12 robins and this is a greater no. than on mt. Constitution and elsewhere on the island. This area is a north exposure. On return observed an imm. bald eagle. There are more butterflies on Orcas than on Lopez Island.
