Spooky = spooky, stray deer

Shy Doe = shy doe, stray female

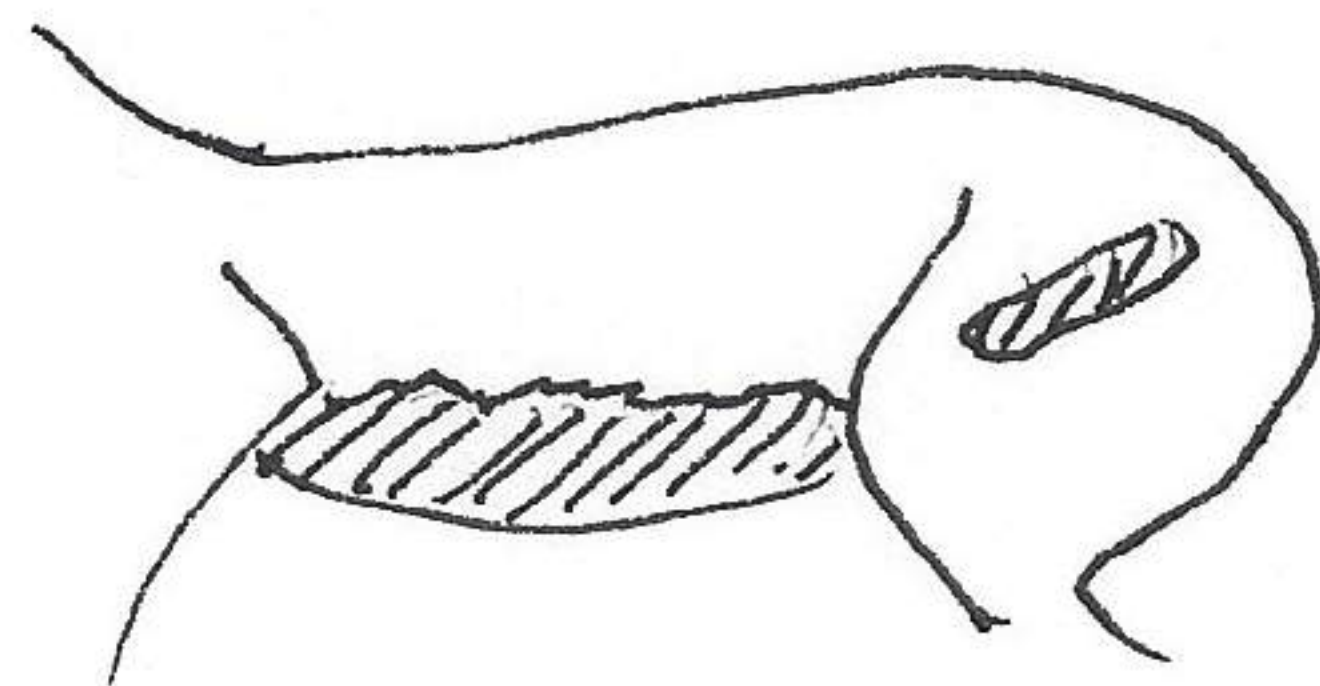
Bimbam = young ♂, young male of ^{local} family or territory group, second year ♂

Little Sister = young ♀, young female of local family or territory group, second year female

Buster = fawn, fawn of local female (local group) (even though it grew beyond a fawn we still referred to it as a fawn).

This date Shy Doe. shows new pelage and is reddish in color and confined to belly & hind quarters.

9:30 A.M. ♂ Eastern gray squirrel
Copulated with ♀ and chasing a second ♀ shortly (3") after.



June 9, 1987

10:20 A.M. bald eagle flew N. past Bee House. Ad. bald eagle at Lopez Village and 3 turkey vultures between home & the village.

June 10, 1987

To Mt. Vernon & Anacortes this A.M. at 8:00 A.M. Bald eagle at Lopez Ferry Terminal flying NW around upright Head,
7:45 P.M. 4 river otter around Lichen Point going N. Put-out at Spring Cove Point and ventured 5' up rocks from water, thence back into water and again put-out a head of Spring Cove (center of beach) where they disappeared into shrubbery and emerged 3 minutes later when they played on exposed logs and at the end of one half submerged log where they search the end of & under the log. 4 minutes later they appeared on top of the log where the largest otter (head & neck to shoulders a light yellowish brown) a ♀? preened the necks of the three young which were all a dark brown. They then swam NNE along shore, fed at edge of water directly below Bee House & then
