

June 18, 1987

2:00 P.M. Trip from Bee House to N end Humphrey Head via rocky shoreline (low tide) Boundary Point, N^{end} Crescent Shoreline and shoreline beyond 2 cove (NE corner Humphrey Head are impossible on rocky shoreline. N or second cove the cliffs enter water without shoreline. From this point trended NW above cliffs, thence up slope thru dense and rugged terrain to a point approx. 150' E of junction of old road to John Saul III new road and Skerrett Road. One ad. ♀ mule deer on this brushy, forested slope allowed me to approach 30' before it left. It was feeding on live leaves of Ocean Spray. Another adult ♀ mule deer was standing in middle of upper John Saul III road. It walked away with food 20' with tail perpendicular, then ran 20' with tail still held perpendicular.

At first Cove N of Otter Cove (at NE bend of Humphrey Head) 6-8 holes in hard sandstone above high tide level made by bivalves (flat-tipped Piddock, Penitella peneta). The name of this cove will be Piddock Cove.

Noted a rufous hummingbird searching cliffs above rocky shoreline at Otter Cove.

9:35 P.M. ad. ♀ deer 'Shy Doe' ^{29"} at shoulders with young deer about size of Buster (last year's fawn). Another ad ♀, 'Spooky' at feeder 31" high at shoulders.

9:35 Last rufous hummingbird at feeder.
