

Mary, Don, Annette and I to Oreas to Check house.
 Adult Bald Eagle at upper slope of mt at Cascade Lake
 Outlet level. Circled to S. Turkey vulture circling
 10'-30' above new cut hay field. Adult glaucous-wing-
 ed gulls on 2 nests on piling at Shaw Island. Returned
 Lopez.

June 26, 1987

8:45 A.M. 'Buster', mule deer at feeder. At this time 'Shy Doe' and
 her fawn arrived at top of trail 20' from feeder, and the
 fawn (now known as 'Teenie') came down trail 10' then returned
 to mother and tried to suckle but doe refused. 'Shy Doe' then
 cautiously approach feeder to 10' and then returned and left
 to trail leading past top stairs & then beyond. Buster remained
 at feeder at all times but was unusually curious of the fawn.

6:40 P.M. 'Shy Doe' arrived at feeder without fawn and fed
 for 9 minutes. Her rump, flanks and hips are noticeably
 thinner as result of recent birth of young. Center of top
 of head between ears & eyes has an area of bare skin the
 size of a quarter. Eyes of Shy Doe have always been more
 bulging outward than Mamma Deer. Height of shoulders
 30". Deer left, walked to top of trail, groomed then left
 to N on lower trail for 30' and layed down, ear backwards
 and horizontal, facing NW. Chewed cud, 68 times each, at
 7:10 P.M. stood up, groomed. 7:05 left resting spot, walked 15
 up slope to upper trail, faced N, inspected several directions with
 ears perpendicular. 7:12 turned around & moved 10' and groomed
 then at 7:15 P.M. returned to feeder. Left 7:19 P.M., top trail, stopped
 5 minutes, then back to where she originally had lain down
 (7:24 P.M.). Chewed cud (56 sec. on one cud), (52 seconds one cud).
 8:02 P.M. Doe stood up from resting spot & groomed body. 8:15 P.M.
 stood up from resting spot, groomed to 8:20 P.M., thence back
 to feeder. Fed 5 1/2" thence leisurely up trail to cliff
 top, thence to top of stairs, thence up trail to lower parking
 lot thence trail to Fralic back yard, thence across
 circular drive way, thence N at 8:32 P.M.

8:35 11^{refuge} hummingbirds at feeder and is more than the usual
 5-7 birds at this time of day. All females except one ♂
 8:40 P.M. 59 waves per minute from SSE., sky clear all day.
