


June 27, 1987

10:00 A.M. 25 harbor seal on Les Reef. (Rocks 1-6). no other seal in area. Rufous hummingbird population average 4, all females. 43 boats at Spencer Spit this evening.

June 28, 1987

8:30 A.M. 'Spooky', mule deer at feeder, 31" high at shoulders. The right ear (inner border) has nick

11:05 imm (some white in head and tail) bald eagle flying S at 60 feet dropped to water and contacted a 4x6' mass of whitish algae but did not secure it. It circled and picked up another object and flew to rocks of Boundary Point and remained until 12:10 when it left and flew 40' above water to 1/2 way to Flower Island where it circled, picked up an object and flew to trees on Licken Point.



1:00 P.M. Average of 15 boats on ferry route N Lopez Sound, both arriving or leaving.

1:05 P.M. no harbor seal on Les Reef or other pullout rocks. 25 glaucomys-crowned gulls, all adults, on Les Reef.

4:00 P.M. Photo 870628-1 of Harold Kleins boat alegning for haul out on boat lift.

5:30 P.M. Long parallel line of debris approached shoreline with increase of currents to N at 1 foot per second. most passed by Boundary Point but the debris headed for Spring Cove circulated in bay in front of Cove.

5:35 P.M. Boat since noon are trending S to Thatcher Pass (90%). At 5:35 there is approx. 4 boats moving S (97%). At noon there were 3 boats at Spencer Spit and now there are 14, moored for tonight.
