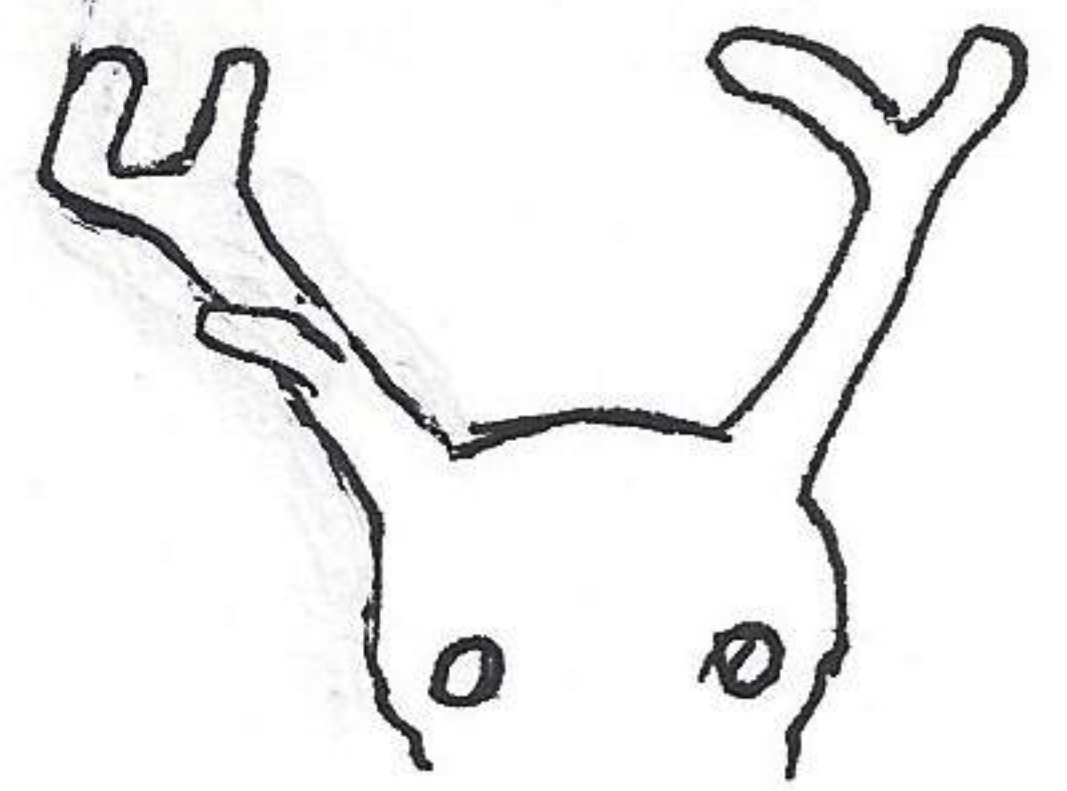


6:00 P.M. Buck mule deer at feeder. (called Single Tyne)
 Antlers approx 10" high and angles
 and alignment irregular. All is
 solid velvet. measured 32 "
 and height of shoulders. This
 buck now named 'Single Tyne' and
 could actually be first generation of
 mummy deer. At feeder it mildly displaced Orphan
 who at one time tried to nurse from the buck which again
 mildly changed positions only. Left on middle trail to N.
 Townsend cheppums, ^{attempted} copulated, then partners reversed act.



July 8, 1987

7:00 A.M. 4 river otter swam steady forward by alternat-
 anally swimming on surface and swimming under water
 and only occasionally moving laterally in search of
 food. The travel time was approximately (from Lichen
 Point to Boundary Point including out reaches of Spring
 Cove) in 4 minutes. At Bee House made 3 photos as
 they passed by.

Adult female not present in group.

9:00 A.M. Two photos of Sister on rocky shoreline below
 Bee House. She fed on leaves of native yellow flower
 at black stain tide zone and clear rocks above. She
 put herself in a vulnerable position of no escape, if her
 approach to shoreline had been blocked off. From here
 she came to deer feeder on NW side of Bee House. She
 left by horizontal benchland to N. Photos 870708-5 and 870708-6

10:30 A.M. Photos Bumbam, mule deer, at feeder area.
 height at shoulders 31 ". He had antlers approx.
 3 3/4 inches long & in velvet.

This deer shows less confidence in us than when last observed
 (see notes some month or so ago).

4:00 P.M. bold eagle circled 300' above Leo Reef and then
 moved in circles to S.

In last 2 days there are fewer (average 3) rufous
 hummingbirds than the past week or summer.
