

The fawn could not get to feeder because of mother but did eat even on the ground and green leaves of a shrub on the rocky cliffs and one dried madrona leaf. The fawn tried to suckle twice but unsuccessful. At one time the fawn left and move up trail to top of cliffs and then returned to mother. At one time Buster approached mother to within 2' and ^{both} extended their necks forward as if to touch noses but mother at that distance moved forward and tried to strike Buster. Buster left to top of cliffs on trail and after Shy Doe finished eating returned to the feeder. The fawn licked the end of the heel of the mother for 30". Social photos:

July 12, 1987

Visited Breming at Everett with Chris, Steve, Matthew, Jim and Marian and Jana Bee (Moss' daughter). Returned with Jana to Lopez.

6:00 P.M. Spooky at feeder and 2, ^{young yearling} mule deer approx 50' away and not associated with Spooky. The fawns were without spots and we believe they are young of mamma deer who was killed June 11. 9:50 P.M. Northern Saw-wet Owl on window seal of master bed-room at Bee House Aegolius acadicus

July 13, 1987

To Lopez Village. At marshland SE 1917 School House observed 2 turkey vultures 150' above field. Jana and I walk out to east Spencer Spit. No birds in lagoon or elsewhere. At Boundary Point, 1 river otter swim by at 20'. Candefish were observed surfacing (one or two at a time) in area. Otter captured at least two but was not responsible for other fish that were jumping out of the water & skimmer water.
