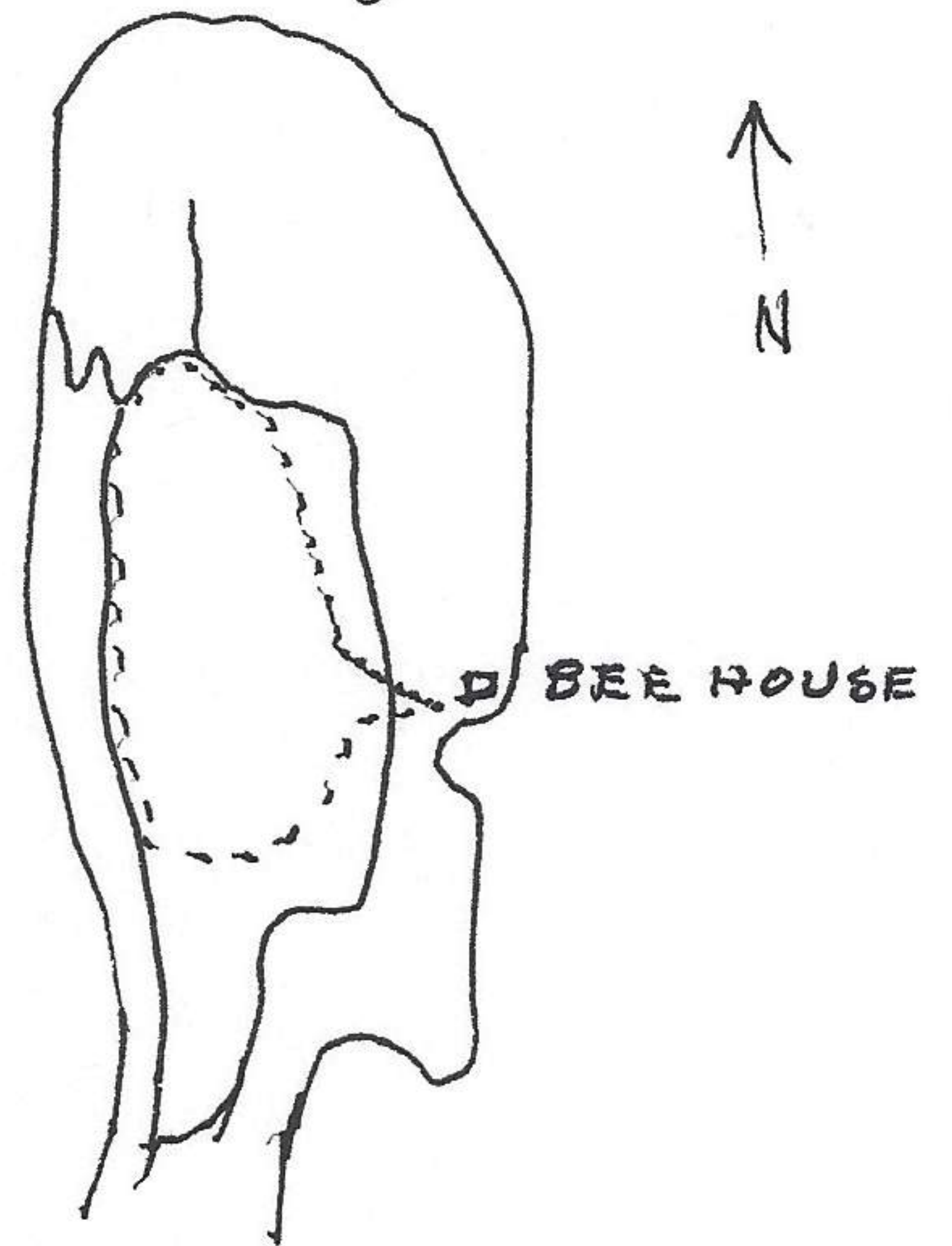


4:30 P.M. to 5:30 P.M. Hikes from Bee House, Horizontal Trail to road, thence trail around S end Humphrey Head to logging trail, thence N to rd that leads down to base of Rock Quarry, thence S to Bee House. 2 Torquins Admiral butterflies, no birds, no mammals. Madrona leaves (dead) on ground and from 3 layers thick to completely covering the ground under most trees. Some trees all in green, others full complement dead yellow leaves still in trees. Insect specimen 870720-1 from W side Humphrey Head where logging trail is at highest point (below Hitchcock's place). It was on perpendicular branch of Madrona and repeatedly returned to same tree. Maple seeds 15 per sq foot on ground ^{under trees}.



5:45 P.M. Adult bald eagle flew SW along shoreline below Bee House some 6' from water and 15' from shore. It alighted 3/4 up Douglas Fir tree above N end Dissected Point. It left after 20 minutes.

Only one hummingbird at feeder today and sugar water down 1/8" (2" dia. cylinder). Observed at least 6:30 P.M.

6:40 P.M. first spotted sandpiper on rocks below Bee House since we moved in house.

The last 2 days I have seen a belted kingfisher ^{spring} use Cove. but rarely so far this summer.

July 21, 1987

9:00 A.M. 1 female rufous hummingbird at feeder.

4:00 P.M. 18 mallard ducks in fresh water pond junction Port Stanley & Cross rds. Killdeer and western sandpiper at Swift's Lagoon.

6:25 P.M. Only one female rufous hummingbird at feeder today. Sugar water down 1/8" since A.M.

Six different mule deer at feeder at one time or rather.

July 22, 1987

10:10 A.M. Shy doe mule deer with fawn 20 1/2" high at shoulders at feeder.

10:30 8 Calif. gulls and 6 Bonaparte gulls along flats from 200' N Leo Reef.
