

8:05 P.M. Shy Doe at feeder. deer of 7:20 A.M. now feeding below house to S.

8:15 P.M. 76 glaucous-winged gulls on Flower Island. An individual gained access to island from Cove on N end and remained with small white dog for 28 minutes. Gulls in 50' of individuals and some others circled continuously overhead from 20'-50', 38 at one time.

8:43 5 rhinoceros auklets 200' N of island, one pigeon guillemot, 12 Bonaparte gulls.

July 24, 1987

9:25 A.M. ^{Rufous} Hummingbird at feeding station. Since July 19th the hummingbird has consumed 1 inch of sugar water. At this rate the hummingbird (or birds) have consumed approx 1.3 the amount of food taken during that time.

9:30-10:00 A.M. Thunder and lightning. Rain not enough to complete cover surfaces.

9:35 Shy doe and fawn have been at feeder for 10 minutes. They did not react to thunder, nor did the eastern gray squirrel or chipmunk. Photo 870724-1 of fawn with doe. Photo 870724-2 fawn alone. They both left by middle trail below Fralich residence. The fawn attempted to suckle from doe 3 times but was refused. Fawn licked hind legs of doe.

9:40 A.M. adult bald eagle flew S past Bee House, around Lichen Point to Swift Bay area.

9:50 A.M. 4 river otter to S investigating shoreline along the way.

July 25, 1987

no rufous hummingbird at feeders this A.M.

9:50 A.M. Purple finch ♂ at porch feeder since last recorded in journal

4:50 P.M. red-tailed hawk flew S in front Bee House at 60' high and 30' from shoreline.
